CONFESSION OF FAITH – WESTMINSTER LARGER CATECHISM 0.25

Psalms for Worship, 146A

Ecclesiastes 2:1-11

Q. 25. Wherein consisteth the sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell?

A.
