Only Luke records this particular anointing. There are three characters in this narrative:

1.Jesus, who shows us what God is really like.

2. The Woman, who remains anonymous except for "sinful" and penitent.

When we realize our sinfulness, as she did, we're led to humble repentance before Christ.

3. The Pharisee, Simon by name, who showed some outward respect toward Christ, yet no heart-love, and was unconverted.

When we feel self-sufficient, when we don't realize our sinfulness before the Holy One, when we are not actually and undeniably aware of our guilt before Christ, we are also led to cold rejection of Jesus' forgiveness.

CONFESSION OF FAITH – WESTMINSTER LARGER CATECHISM Q'S 34 & 35

- **Q. 34**. How was the covenant of grace administered under the Old Testament?
- **A.** The covenant of grace was administered under the Old Testament, by promises, prophecies, sacrifices, circumcision, the passover, and other types and ordinances, which did all fore-signify Christ then to come, and were for that time sufficient to build up the elect in faith in the promised Messiah, by whom they then had full remission of sin, and eternal salvation.
- **Q. 35**. How is the covenant of grace administered under the New Testament?
- **A.** Under the New Testament, when Christ the substance was exhibited, the same covenant of grace was and still is to be administered in the preaching of the Word, and the administration of the sacraments of baptism and the Lord's supper; in which grace and salvation are held forth in more fullness, evidence, and efficacy, to all nations.

OLD TESTAMENT SCRIPTURE READING

Genesis 8:1-12

But God remembered Noah and all the beasts and all the livestock that were with him in the ark. And God made a wind blow over the earth, and the waters subsided. ² The fountains of the deep and the windows of the heavens were closed, the rain from the heavens was restrained, ³ and the waters receded from the earth continually. At the end of 150 days the waters had abated, ⁴ and in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, the ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat. ⁵ And the waters continued to abate until the tenth month; in the tenth month, on the first day of the month, the tops of the mountains were seen. 6 At the end of forty days Noah opened the window of the ark that he had made ⁷ and sent forth a raven. It went to and fro until the waters were dried up from the earth. 8 Then he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters had subsided from the face of the ground. 9 But the dove found no place to set her foot, and she returned to him to the ark, for the waters were still on the face of the whole earth. So he put out his hand and took her and brought her into the ark with him. ¹⁰ He waited another seven days, and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark. 11 And the dove came back to him in the evening, and behold, in her mouth was a freshly plucked olive leaf. So Noah knew that the waters had subsided from the earth. 12 Then he waited another seven days and sent forth the dove, and she did not return to him anymore.


