Sermon Outline: "The Internal Law About Anger"

Matthew 5:21-26

- I. Understand the main principle: Anger and insult toward humans are tantamount to murder in God's sight.
- II. Christ goes on to give two examples of the priority of right relationships.
 - A. The first takes place within the context of the church.
 - B. The second example is drawn from the context of secular or civil courts and pertains to an enemy or one outside of the church.
