

John 3:16-21 NKJV

For God so loved the world *that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should **not perish** but have **everlasting life**.*

For God did not send His **Son** into the world to condemn the **world**, but that the world **through Him** might be **saved**.

“He who **believes in Him** is **not** condemned; but he who does not believe is **condemned already**, because he has not believed in the name of the **only** begotten **Son of God**.

And this is the **condemnation**, that the light has come into the world, and **men loved darkness rather than light**, because their deeds were evil.

For **everyone practicing evil hates the light** and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed.

But he who does the **truth comes to the light**, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God.”

[**Condemnation** *is like saying the crime you will be blamed for.*]

[*interjections in brackets*] **John 3:16-21 NKJV**

If you want to be saved but think that you *cannot* be saved because of **sinful behaviors** *that you think you might do again*, **DO NOT WORRY!**

God already **knows** that **you cannot overcome your sins** by yourself.

Jesus does not want you to clean yourself up *and then* come to Him.

Come AS YOU ARE and TRUST Him.

Jesus will clean you up.

It IS wrong to sin against God.

If you agree with that and you are truly sorry that you have sinned against God, **all you need to do is:**

- change your **MIND** —
change your way of thinking.
- **God will change your ways.**

Trust Him.

And let Him work.

If you are **still not sure**, but you **DO NOT** want to spend eternity suffering in HELL, **sincerely ask God to help you see that HE IS REAL.**

["The **god**" (*god with the little 'g' is Satan*)]

"The **god** of this age **has blinded the minds of unbelievers**, so that they **cannot see** the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God."

[*interjections in brackets*]**2 Corinthians 4:4NIV**

The ***unbelievers*** in this case is **you**.
Ask God to unblind your mind, and He will.

But it is **very** possible that you are being oppressed or even possessed by one or more **demon** spirits.

There could be times you have demons **controlling** your **mind** or influencing your thoughts and **you may or may not even know it**.

Ask Jesus to save you from them, **and He will**.

"Jesus, please save me!" — as a sincere and heartfelt plea — will **make all demons** leave you **IMMEDIATELY**.

OK, **now to be *Saved*** AS IN *not to spend eternity in Hell*
(and **not to just be *dispossessed***
OR dis - oppressed of evil demons)...

If you declare with your mouth, "**Jesus is Lord,**" and believe in your heart that **God raised Him** from the dead, you will be saved.
Romans 10:9 NIV

Being Saved in this way will not stop you from having to face the **terrible** and **scary** things going on around you.

But your salvation IS THE most valuable possession you can have to take with you, **and it cannot be taken from you.**

When you are Saved, the Holy Spirit lives inside you, and **He will never leave you.**

If you want to be Saved, say the following prayer aloud

(from your heart and mind).

(If you cannot speak aloud, do your best).

The exact words are not as important as what is in your heart as you say this prayer.

 Dear **Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness.**

I believe **You died for my sins**  **and rose from the dead.**

 **I confess my sins** and invite You to come into my heart and my life.

I want to trust and follow You as my Lord and Savior.

I ask this in the name of *Jesus*, amen.



"...there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over **one sinner who repents.**"

Luke 15:10 NKJV

If you just trusted in Jesus Christ as your personal savior, CONGRATULATIONS.

You may not feel any different so soon, **but your life is totally** changed forever.

Your **Eternal Life** IS **promised** to **be wonderful.**

Your life and circumstances **at the present** are **not** promised at all, much less **promised** to be wonderful.

But let us assure you that **Jesus** does **love** you and **He WILL NEVER** leave you **no matter what** you will face.

"And the **LORD**, He **IS** the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; **do not fear nor be dismayed.**"

Deuteronomy 31:8 NKJV

If you asked Jesus to save you from any evil **spirits**, **but** you ***did not*** ask Him to **save you from your sins**, you are leaving yourself wide open for much **worse than you were dealing** with before.

Matthew 12:43-45 tells us:
 an unclean or evil spirit that leaves a person and then **returns**
[implying that it will definitely return]
 and **finds** its original home **[you]**
 empty **[*not having the Holy Spirit*]**,
 that evil spirit **then leaves again** and
 comes back with **7 more** evil spirits
 that are **even worse** than the first.

When the **Holy Spirit**
 is within you **NO EVIL SPIRIT**
 WILL EVER possess you!

You *can* still be subjected to trials by
Oppressing spirits BUT you can and
***should* pray for protection** (more
 on prayer later. It is one of the **most**
important parts of this guidebook).

You are **of God**, little children, and have overcome them, because **He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.**
1 John 4:4 NKJV

Because of the **extreme evil** that surrounds you, it is so important that you remember:

God is never taken by surprise.

God knows all things **BEFORE** they happen, and **nothing happens that God does NOT allow.**

That can seem severe and harsh, all things considered.

But here you are. *And you would not be* reading this, receiving God's word to get *SAVED, without* the previous *hard times.*

Therefore, know this: **no matter what** you face, you are **NOT FACING it** alone.

Jesus is with you and if you have been saved, **the Holy Spirit is inside you.**

Jesus has *already* gotten you through ***whatever*** you will face, even if getting you through means taking you home, ***to heaven.***

You will be back and in a better *body with the rest of us.* And there is *SO much* ***more to tell you.***

On that note, it is important to understand that *the enemy*, who is **Satan, is NOT the *arch-nemesis of God.***

Satan is a created being, and he has already been defeated.

Jesus *defeated* Satan when He (Jesus) was crucified and raised from the dead.

Satan has no power or authority that God does not *allow* him (Satan) to have.

God, who is the *Father, Son, and Holy Spirit*, **IS ALL powerful and holy.**

Satan has many fallen angels and demons under his authority, and they all have the **same destination** ahead of them — **eternal damnation**.

You, *IF* you have chosen to follow Jesus and given your life to Him, **have nothing to fear**.

All you need to do when faced with *anything* demonic, is **cry out to Jesus and He will save you**.

Being *saved* is spiritual and everlasting.

Your physical body is only temporary. And whichever way you go, heaven or hell, you **DO** get the new body upgrade.

If you **are saved**, you will have a new ***Glorified–Forever*** body that is without the corruption of sin.

If you **are NOT saved**, you will have a new ***Forever*** body that will **BURN** easily **without** *EVER* turning to ashes.

It is assumed that you found this **guidebook** because **SO MANY** people just suddenly **disappeared**.

And you were left behind.

If you were left behind, you have **probably found** this in someone else's home or vehicle and the reason you are there — in someone else's stuff — probably means **you are looking for supplies you can no longer buy.**

What you need to do now: **take cover** in a **secure location** *OR*

AS CLOSE TO SECURE AS YOU CAN FIND — a hidden or semi-hidden place is best.

Gather any **food, water,** medical supplies, *AND* weapons (for defense) you can find.

And take this **guidebook** with you *and* the **Bible** that should be with it.

As soon as you can,
FINISH reading this guidebook and **keep it with you** for reference.
