To our JEWISH FRIENDS:

Throughout history, **EVIL** people have labeled themselves **Christians** and committed unspeakable acts against the Jewish people.

Satan is a **deceiver**, and he wants to **keep you away** from your Messiah.

You have something very special, and we want to make sure you know what that is.

The God who made a covenant with Abraham for your people is an awesome and amazing God. **We love Him**.

He has given us this opportunity to **share our love with you** through this Emergency Guide.

Your God is our God. Your Tanakh is our Tanakh. We *CALL* it something different, but it *is* the **same** writings.

The **Hebrew** word Mašíaḥ or **Mashiach** (or, in English, Messiah) means the **Anointed** One.

The **Greek** word for **Mashiach** is **Christos**. This is where we get the word **Christ**.

Yeshua, or as we call Him, **Jesus**.... He is *the* **Christ**, the **anointed one** as in **Jesus** is *the* **Messiah**.

Please do not stop reading because you think you have heard this before or because you think this is an attempt to make you believe in a god other than the God of Israel.

That is not true. And this information is **too important** for you to ignore. We cannot force you to change your mind, so there is **no harm** in reading this.

We ask that you do **one thing** before you continue reading: seek God with your heart.

Please take a moment and ask *HIM* to reveal the truth to you. He alone will give you the good judgement to know that **what we are saying is the truth.**

We cannot convince you of anything.

[God is plural but there is only one God]

In the beginning **God created** the heavens and the earth And the **Spirit of God** [a separate individual] was hovering over the face of the waters.

Genesis 1:26 NKJV

Then **God said**, "**Let Us** make man in **Our image**, according to **Our likeness**; ..."


[interjections in brackets] Genesis 1:27 NKJV

So **God created** man in **His own** image;... [still only ONE GOD.]

This image does not give anyone the key to understanding God.

He IS the I Am!

[interjections in brackets] Isaiah 48:16 NKJV

"Come near to **Me**, hear this: **I** have not spoken in secret from the beginning;

From the time that it was, **I** was there. And now the **Lord God** [the Father]

and **His Spirit** [the Holy Spirit]

[**They**, Father and Spirit] Have sent **Me**. [Me is the 2nd person of the Triune Godhead. **Sent** as in **Sent** from heaven to **save us**]

[interjections in brackets] Psalm 2:7 NKJV

"I will declare the decree:

The LORD [the Father] has said to Me,

[2nd person of the Triune Godhead.]

'You ARE My Son

[2nd person of the *Triune Godhead IS NOW* identified as the **Son of God**.] Today I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU.

Isaiah 9:6 NKJV

For unto us **a Child is born**, unto us **a Son is given**, and the government will be upon His shoulder.

And **His name** will be called Wonderful Counselor, **Mighty God**, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 6:8 NKJV

Also I heard the voice of **the Lord**, saying:

"Whom shall **I** send, And who will go for **Us**?"

Religious or not, being Jewish, you should at least have some knowledge from the traditions that have been passed down to you.

So, we will attempt to explain and **reference scripture** without going through the entire Hebrew Bible.

Isaiah 53:1-6 NKJV

Who has believed our report?
And to whom has the arm of
the LORD been revealed?
For He shall grow up before Him as a
tender plant,
And as a root out of dry ground.

[interjections in brackets] Isaiah 53:1-6 NKJV

He has no form or comeliness;

And when we see Him,
There is no beauty that we should desire Him.
He is despised and rejected by men, [Can you see the rejection?]
A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief.
And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him;
He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Surely He has borne our griefs
And carried our sorrows;
Yet we esteemed Him stricken,
Smitten by God, and afflicted.
But He was wounded for our
transgressions,

He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him,

And by His stripes we are healed.

All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; [In some way, we each have.] And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

Psalm 79:9 NKJV

Help us, **O God of our salvation**, for the glory of Your name; And deliver us, and provide **atonement for our sins**, For Your name's sake!

God's original plan was to be in fellowship with man. But Adam and Eve caused sin to enter the world and interrupted that plan.

Sin caused mankind to be separated from God. So, God chose Abram to bring into the world a chosen people to set

Abraham... Isaac... Jacob (Israel).

You know this story. We can skip ahead a bit.

apart and show Himself to the world.

All the law given to Moses and the animal blood sacrifices were **never meant** to be a **permanent** solution to sin.

Those could never bring God's chosen people **or ANY people** back into *perfect fellowship* with God.

Since SIN was *NOT PART* of God's original plan, **AND BECAUSE** SIN stops us from having *perfect fellowship* with God,

He made **a plan to save us!**AND HE gave us clues about **HOW**.

There are prophecies about a **Suffering Servant** Messiah *AND* prophecies about a **Conquering** Messiah. **ALL** of the prophecies **MUST** come to pass. It is **obvious** that the conquering Messiah has **not yet come**. The state of the world makes that an *obvious truth*.

And it only makes sense that a suffering Messiah would come **BEFORE** a conquering Messiah.

And why would there **be a**need for a suffering Messiah

AFTER a conquering Messiah?

And where would a suffering Messiah

fit into the PROMISES God made to King David about the everlasting kingdom?

The **good news** is the suffering servant Messiah has already come.

All of those **prophecies were fulfilled** through Yeshua
(Jesus), the Christ.

But what about the *LAW*, you ask?

God introduced the concept of the **substitute sacrifice** when God told Abraham to take *his only*son and offer him as a sacrifice. **His only son** is a key phrase because Yeshua is the 2nd person of the **Elohim**. Yeshua is the **Son of God**.

Abraham trusted God and God provided a substitute for that sacrifice.

In this same way, Yeshua, the only Son of God, became our substitute sacrifice.

And He fulfilled the prophecy from Isaiah 7 stating He would be born from a virgin and be called Immanuel (God with us)

Because He IS God and He

literally came to be with us.

Yeshua is the Son of God who left
the glory of heaven to be born as a
lowly suffering servant...

...to be proven worthy of being the sacrifice **for our sins** and **for your sins**.

For the sins of **all mankind** because He, being **God** *in the flesh*, was the only one who could live a sinless life. *His sacrifice was perfect*.

And He is coming back **very soon** as the *conquering Messiah*. And there are so many wonderful things coming since *He will* fulfill ALL of those prophecies too.

It is important to know that to be part of **His everlasting kingdom**, you **must first** recognize what He did for all of us (**Jew and Non-Jew**) when He came as the suffering servant **Messiah**.

You may be asking: Why DO we believe in the Jewish Messiah?

Because we have examined the evidence with our hearts AND our minds.

So much archeological evidence giving proof of the **historic facts** contained in the Hebrew Bible. *AND* the **Jewish people** themselves **are a miracle**.

For **2000 years** the Jewish people were scattered outside of the land.

God said He would scatter His people. He also said He would **bring His people back**.

God chose to reveal His power to the world through the Jewish people. And only God is capable of the miracle of a nation being born in a day. May 14, 1948

And God declared that He would accomplish that exact thing more than a thousand years BEFORE they were even sent out of the land. God's word is the Truth.

Eyewitness Testimony

The **first four books** of the Christian New Testament are called the *Gospels* because they are the **Good News proclaimed from eyewitness accounts** of the miracles of Jesus Christ.

Those miracles include rising from the dead on the 3rd day and **rising back** into the glory of heaven.

These **miracles** were witnessed by many people. Two eyewitnesses wrote down their testimonies. Those are **two** of the **first four** books of the New Testament.

The other two Gospels were written from **interviews with multiple eyewitnesses** of Jesus from His life, ministry, death, rising from the dead, and the rising back into heaven.

And they were *not just random people*. One of them, **Luke**, was a **Jewish** doctor and therefore an investigator by nature.

How can we believe these writings so completely? That brings us to Exhibit 3.

Exhibit 3

So many People Died Proclaiming His Truth!

Nobody goes to their death proclaiming a lie. Nobody!

The persecution of the early church lasted beyond the first eyewitnesses.

Why? Their testimony of Jesus caused them to be put in prison, to be tortured, and even put to death.

They would not renounce their claims even to save their lives or the lives of their families. Other people saw this and also believed.

ALL except **1** of the **12 apostles** (the closest followers of Jesus) WERE **PUT TO DEATH** for their testimony of Jesus.

No one goes to their death clinging to a lie. The one apostle who is believed to have died of *natural causes* was also willing to die for his belief in Jesus.

He was imprisoned and it is even believed that he *miraculously* did not die despite being boiled in oil before being sentenced to work as a slave on the island of Patmos.

The WORD OF GOD

God told us about the new covenant.

English translation of the Hebrew Bible

Yirmiyahu (Jeremiah) 31:30

Behold, days are coming, says the LORD, and I will form a covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, a new covenant.

Christian Bible: New King James Version

Jeremiah 31:31

"Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—
