

[interjections in brackets] **Daniel 9:26 NKJV**

“And **after the sixty-two weeks** Messiah shall be cut off [*killed*], but not for Himself; [*for our sins, not His. He had no sin.*]

And the people of **the prince who is to come** Shall destroy the city [*Jerusalem*] and the sanctuary [*the temple*]. ...

AFTER THE SIXTY-TWO WEEKS

In **605 BC** the **prophet Daniel** was **captured** and taken to **Babylon** and **Jerusalem** was **destroyed**.

62 weeks is understood as 62 sevens as in **62 times 7**, which is **490**. But it is **years** not days or weeks.

The 62 weeks Daniel refers to in this verse is **accepted** as the period of time **beginning** when the **command** to **rebuild Jerusalem** was given and **ending with Yeshua** being crucified [*killed*].

This was after He **entered Jerusalem riding** on the **donkey** for the Passover feast.

Jesus was the Passover sacrifice that was made once and for all time when he was crucified a few days later.

the prince who is to come

In 70 AD, **after** Jesus **died** and was **raised** from the dead, **Jerusalem** and the **temple** were ***destroyed again***.

The Roman General **Titus**, who **destroyed** Jerusalem in 70 AD, **was** indeed a **prince** [***the prince who is to come***]. He was the **son** of **Emperor** Vespasian, and he later became emperor.

The 62 weeks ***and then*** Messiah *Yeshua* was killed (cut off) ***and then AFTER that*** the *Prince* General Titus had his people destroy the city and the sanctuary, **just as Daniel 9:26 states.**

Zechariah 9:9 NKJV

“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!
Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, **your King is coming to you;**
He *is* just and having salvation,
Lowly and riding on a donkey,
A colt, the foal of a donkey.

DONKEY

[interjections in brackets] **John 12:14-15 NKJV**

(*Christian Bible: New Testament*)

Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written:

"Fear not, daughter of Zion;
Behold, your King is coming,
Sitting on a **donkey's colt.**"

[the book of John, also known as the **gospel** of John, is the **EYEWITNESS** account of Jesus's ministry **by the Apostle John**, a follower of Jesus Christ].

DONKEY

[interjections in brackets] **Isaiah 7:14 NKJV**

Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: **Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son,** and shall call His name Immanuel
[Immanuel, meaning *God with us*, as in He will **BE** God with us].

BIRTH

[interjections in brackets] **Luke 1:30-34 TLV**
(*Christian Bible: New Testament*)

The angel spoke to her, "Do not be afraid, Miriam, for you have found favor with God. Behold, **you will become pregnant and give birth to a son**, and you shall call His name **Yeshua**. He will be great and will be called *Ben-Elyon*. *Adonai Elohim* will give Him the **throne of David**, His father. He shall reign over the **house of Jacob** for all eternity, and His kingdom will be without end."

Miriam said to the angel, "**How can this be, since I am not intimate with a man?**"

[Matthew was a tax collector who Jesus called to be one of His followers].

“**But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah,**
Though you are little among
 the thousands of Judah,
Yet out of you shall come forth to
Me The One to be Ruler in Israel,
Whose goings forth are from of old,

*means **He is God.**]*

(Christian Bible: New Testament)

Matthew 2:1 NKJV

Now after **Jesus was born in**
Bethlehem of Judea in the days of
 Herod the king, behold, wise men from
 the East came to Jerusalem

BETHLEHEM

(Christian Bible: New Testament)

Luke 2:1-7 NKJV

And it **came to pass** in those days *that* a **decree** went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. This **census** first took place while Quirinius was governing Syria. So **all went to be registered**, everyone to his own city.

Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the **city of David, which is called Bethlehem**, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with **Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child**. So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. And she brought forth her **firstborn Son**, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

They said therefore among themselves, "**Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it**, whose it shall be," that the Scripture might be fulfilled which says:

"They divided My garments among them,
