What is expected of me now?

Here are **the basic practices** that are expected of you once you have chosen to follow Christ.

- >Trust in God
 - NOT displayed in jumping off of buildings or handling poisonous snakes or other stupid things of that nature. Do NOT TEST God.
- > Prayer See page 134
 - NOT meditation or weird prayer.
 - just a simple conversation with God.
- > Studying God's Word See page 219
 - which is the Holy Bible (from Genesis to Revelation).

- > Worship
 - ONLY *God* is worthy of *OUR* praise and worship.
 - Everyone worships something.
 - ✓ We give worship by devoting our time and energy in thought and deed to something or someone.
 - ✓ ONLY God is deserving of worship.

Choose CAREFULLY

WHO and WHAT *YOU* **focus** your **thoughts** on and **devote** your **time** to!

Worship can be a prayer or a song

Be sure to **Thank God** regularly. It will remind you HOW MUCH He has done for you.

Here is a simple song idea: make up your own tune with the following words and sing it throughout the day.

Praise the Lord, oh my soul, and glory to the King.

- ➤ CHURCH Form and / or participate in a CHURCH.
 - *IF* possible or as close as possible.
 - Form a church only IF millions of people have disappeared.
 Otherwise find a solid, Bibleteaching church to join and participate in.
 - Participation includes praying, which anyone can do no matter their age or abilities. And prayer IS the most important thing for you now.
- > Spreading the message of Jesus Christ so other people can be saved!
 - This is your **NEW PURPOSE** in life.

Being **TOO** concerned with **rules** is almost like **embracing** religion.

It is **best not to veer too far** from the **basics** mentioned in this section.

Ask God, and He will give you wisdom and direction.

Jesus died on the cross, but
He did not stay on the cross.

He was
buried in a
tomb and
rose from the dead on the 3rd day.

And HE IS coming back!

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again [given us a new birth OR allowed us to be BORN AGAIN] TO a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, [BORN AGAIN means the same as being SAVED.

This verse tells us that God's mercy has allowed us to be saved.]

Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

[You must be saved to go to heaven]
