About Confessing Sins

If you choose to confess a sin to another person, that is ok, but it is not necessary. They have plenty of their own sins to worry about.

It is **very important** to know that **no man (person)** has the *AUTHORITY* to forgive your sins.


Except for personal sins when asking Forgiveness for a wrong done to the person being asked.

Forgiveness of any sin can only come from God through Jesus. Because your sin was against God before your sin was against any other person.

And it is **important** that you **do not** get confused by this...

Jesus IS God. But our sins are forgiven through the sacrifice Jesus made when He died on the cross and rose again 3 days later.

All 3 are Separate Individuals All 3 are One God



All 3 Glorify Each Other

Do not try to figure all of this out. Our human brains **cannot comprehend** something **so Infinite and Great**.

This **image** is meant to **help** you, but it **will not** give you the **key** to **understanding God**.

For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, [do not get confused, Jesus IS both Man and God. And, when you pray, you should ask all things in the name of Jesus.]

[Interjections in brackets] 1 Timothy 2:5 NKJV

You can speak directly to God any time you want. **He never sleeps** and He is always able to hear you. *He knows your every thought*. You never need *anyone* to mediate between you and God.

But, if you have committed a sin against someone, confess it to that person and **sincerely** ask their **forgiveness**.

Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled [apologize] to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

[Interjections in brackets] Matthew 5:23-24 NKJV

But you **cannot force** them to **forgive you**. If they do not forgive you, that is between **them** and **God**.

If **you ask** God, **He will** forgive **you**. And that is all the forgiveness you need.

Also important:

You CANNOT *EARN* **forgiveness** for any sin by **DOING any**THING.

Not even *repeating* words of a prayer or standing in a corner for 15 minutes per sin.

Writing *I will not sin* 500 times for each sin is a *waste of time and paper*.

The **good news** is that **you are** already forgiven.

You just need to *confess the sin to God*. Then ask Him to **forgive you**.

And immediately you can know with confidence that He has forgiven you.

And IF you are truly sorry for sinning, you will at least not want to do it again.
