Prayer

Now this is the **confidence** that we have in Him, that **if we ask** anything **according** to *HIS WILL*, **He hears us**.

1 John 5:14 NKJV

The **most important** thing about **praying** *IS* **sincerity**.

There is **not any specific way** you need to pray **or words** you always need to say.

You do not need a specific place or time to pray. Pray **standing**, sitting, **kneeling**, lying in bed....

But you should **ask all things in the name of Jesus.**

Prayer is or should be a conversation between you and God.

Rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer.

Romans 12:12 NKJV





The only true peace you will have in this time of Tribulation will be reading God's word and the time you spend praying.

You should always pray and ask God to **protect** you.

He may choose to **miraculously** preserve you, for His purpose.

ALWAYS be about the FATHER'S Business!

You are at your **strongest** when you are **on your knees in prayer**.

No chanting. No communing with the spirits. No meditation to a higher plain of existence.

All of these practices can cause you to be engaged in communication with demon spirits. That is *Not* Allowed!

In general, you want to **try** to continually **focus** your thoughts upward toward God (this does **NOT** mean **mindless meditation** or trying to reach a **higher spiritual plain**).

But your goal is to be in constant conversation (prayer) with God.

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 NKJV

Let us remind you that you are not perfect and are not expected to be.

You will NOT be able to maintain this prayerful conversation **constantly**.

That is not something you are likely to achieve here on earth. But redirecting your focus on a regular basis back toward Jesus will give you comfort.

That **does not mean** *ALL* of your prayers **will be** answered the way you might want.

In fact, from many of our personal experiences we have often been surprised at how God has answered our prayers.

But God CAN answer immediately, and **He CAN** answer exactly as you asked and expected.

Sometimes the answer is **NO**. Sometimes it is **WAIT**.
