Death

Death is not easy to talk about. **No one wants to** *think about it* much less *talk* about it. But the odds are, you have already come *very close* to it.

If you are saved, you have nothing to fear — but that is an easy thing to say and something else when it is put to the test....

We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord.

[with our trust in Jesus, we KNOW we will be with Him the moment we die, OR we are caught up, raptured, out of this world. And we will be given new physical bodies.]

[Interjections in brackets] 2 Corinthians 5:8 NKJV

When you trust in Jesus you are saved and, **Death is NOT a Punishment.** It is also *Not* THE END!

If or **when** it happens, it is allowed by God, or it Would Not Happen.

If it does happen, you go home immediately to heaven to *LIVE* with God and with us too. You will be removed from the horrors and persecution you are now facing.

On the other side of this time of Tribulation and judgment, there is so much more you will be excited to know about covered later in this guidebook.

When a believer dies, they are with Jesus in heaven *immediately*.

Death is separation. **Separation** *OF the* **soul** and **spirit** *FROM the* **physical body**.

But that is not the end.





On the other hand, the *UNBELIEVER* is immediately taken to a place called *Gehenna*, which is **Hell** but more like a **holding place** before the **final Hell** which is the *lake of fire*.

Do not get confused Hell is Hell and not a pleasant place to spend forever.

For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:38-39 NKJV

Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. [This verse is NOT talking about Death. However, it is a picture of the peace that Jesus offers from our struggles in life.]

[Interjections in brackets] Matthew 11:28 NKJV

Psalm 23 NKJV

The **LORD** is my shepherd; I shall not want.

He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the **still waters**.

He restores my soul;

He leads me in the paths of **righteousness For His name's sake.**

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the *shadow of death*,

I will fear no evil; For You are with me;

Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;

You anoint my head with oil;

My cup runs over.

Surely **goodness** and **mercy** shall follow me

All the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of

the LORD Forever.

Psalm 23 NKJV

In everything *PRAISE* GOD.

Even in - **ESPECIALLY in** - suffering.

It may seem like that is the last thing you want to do – give praise and thanks to God when you are suffering either physically OR emotionally – but HIS word tells us to PRAISE GOD in ALL things.

True healing comes *from* God and there is comfort and healing that comes with being thankful to God.

The following **passages** of scripture — Revelation 6:9-11, 7:9-14, and 20:4-6 — tell of the people who are **martyred and become the** *Tribulation Saints*.

But the Bible also tells us that there are some people who will be alive like you are right now at the end of the Great Tribulation.

That being **said**, the **chances** of ending up in the **group** with the **martyrs** is relatively **easier** than **remaining** in the **group** of those **who** might survive.

The Tribulation Saints

When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been SLAIN for the word of God and for the testimony which they held.

Revelation 6:9 NKJV

Fifth Seal: The Cry of the Martyrs

And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge OUR blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.

Revelation 6:10-11 NKJV

[Interjections in brackets] Revelation 7:9-14 NKJV

After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing [they are now standing, not still under the alter] before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, saying:

"Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, **Thanksgiving** and **honor** and power and might, *Be* to our God forever and ever. Amen."

Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?"

And I said to him, "Sir, you know."
So he said to me, "These are **the ones who come out of the great tribulation**,
and washed their robes and made them
white in the blood of the Lamb.

The Saints Reign with Christ 1,000 Years

And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them.

Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had NOT worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their

hands. And they lived and reigned with

Christ for a **thousand years**.

But the rest of the dead did not live again UNTIL the thousand years were finished [people who died and were not saved].

This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.

[Just because only 1000 years are mentioned here, does not mean that is all there is to be. NO. Forever IS way more than 1000 years.]

[Interjections in brackets] Revelation 20:4-6 NKJV

But the cowardly, UNBELIEVING, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

[Literally everyone ever born, except for Jesus, fits on that list. If for nothing more than being a liar. But if we are honest, at least most of us will admit that we have sinned by doing more than just lying.

We all deserve the lake of fire.

But God's grace changes that. Our

Salvation is secure. The moment we put

our trust in Jesus we received a

FULL Pardon for ALL of our sins.]

[Interjections in brackets] Revelation 21:8 NKJV

The *beast or his image* refers to the **Antichrist** who is the lawless one, the **new world leader** mentioned earlier.

Those who **do not take** the **MARK** of the Beast are **beheaded BUT they** will **LIVE and REIGN with Christ**.





About the **Second Death** mentioned in the two previous verses....

Remember *DEATH* is **not the End**. Death is **Separation**. The first death, as we typically think of death, is the **separation** of the soul and spirit from the physical **body** as we know it.

No matter which way we go, Heaven or Hell, we all get the physical body upgrade into a Forever physical body.

The Forever-Glorified body is perfect without sin. Sin is the root cause of the decay in our first physical body.

The Forever body CANNOT DIE.

But the Second Death comes after the final judgement when the people who do not want to love God are thrown into the Lake of Fire in their new made to burn Forever bodies.

And even worse, the Second Death is the complete Separation from God, and *THAT IS* the truest definition of Hell. Forever and ever and ever and ever... See page 212 for a closer look at Hell.
