Finding them may be the **challenge**. It will be dangerous for anyone to advertise a belief in Jesus.

If you are able to belong to a small group of people for survival, it is our hope that you all trust Jesus and can help each other with basic needs and safety but also to have a common goal in Christ.

Studying God's word together and praying together will strengthen and comfort all of you. There is strength in fellowship, and power in prayer.

NOT forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but **exhorting** one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Hebrews 10:25 NKJV

Spreading the **Good News** about **Jesus** to others *must be* your # 1 purpose.

That is the *Father's business* you should be about doing. There is not much time left and then it will be too late.

It is not too late for you but what about the other people who do not know about Jesus yet?

Could they be saved if you told them?

If you do not tell them, FOREVER is a long time for them to SUFFER.

You may be able to **share** Jesus covertly. You should **try** to do that as long as you can. But, when confronted you must **never**, EVER **deny Jesus**. Even when it means you will **die**.

You will be hunted. You MAY be tortured, even to death.

But if you have Jesus, death only ends the torment. And then your new life begins.
