BOTTOM LINE

Serving others is a powerful expression of Worship to our Heavenly Father.

SCRIPTURE

Matthew 20:17-28 NIV Philippians 2:3-7

MESSAGE OVERVIEW

This message teaches that worship is more than singing—it's our response to who God is and what He has done for us. Jesus modeled true greatness not through power or position, but through serving others, even giving His life as a ransom for many. In the same way, we worship our Heavenly Father when we choose to serve others in big and small ways, often in unseen and inconvenient moments.

DISCUSSION GUIDE

- What's the worst chore or job you ever had to do?
- How does serving others connect to worship?
- Our culture says success comes from power, popularity, or possessions.
 Jesus says greatness comes from serving. Which one do you find yourself chasing more?
- Do you think it's possible to serve others with the wrong motives? What might that look like?
- How can you tell the difference between serving to get noticed and serving out of worship to God?

- Where do you see opportunities to serve in your home, your school, your church, or your friend group?
- What's one practical way you could choose to serve someone this week as an act of worship?
- How would your family, friend group, school, or church look different if more people lived with the mindset of serving as worship?
- How can you start surrendering once you leave this weekend?
