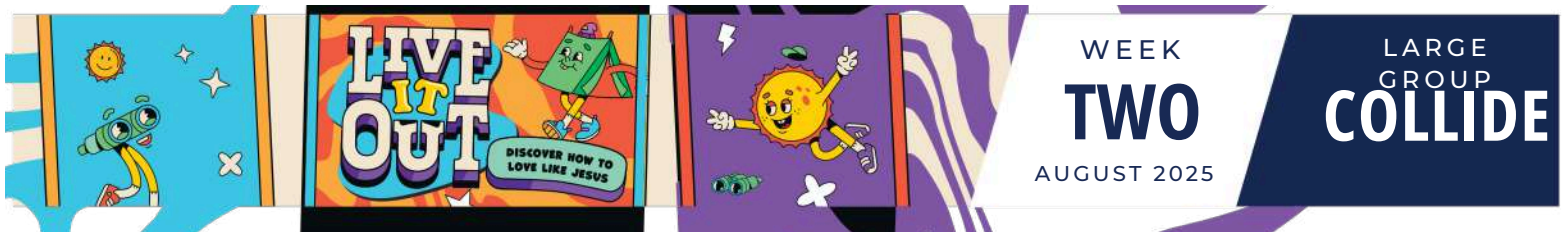

Today's Bible Story: Forgive One Another (Jesus Forgives Peter) • Colossians 3:13

Today's Key Question: What makes it hard to forgive?

Today's Bottom Line: Forgive one another.

OPENER

HOST: "What is going on my people! I am so excited to start another amazing week together here at Collide! Last month, we went to camp to learn to live like Jesus. And we're headed back this month!

We've talked about several ways to share the love of Jesus, what are ways to do that so far—and I'll give you a hint. They all end with 'one another.' Anyone have any ideas? (Pause for responses.)

"We can love like Jesus by living in peace with one another... by looking out for one another... by encouraging one another... and by accepting one another.

There are lots more ways too, which we can read about in the Bible. (Hold up Bible.) We'll talk about a really important one today.

Now, let's stand and worship together!

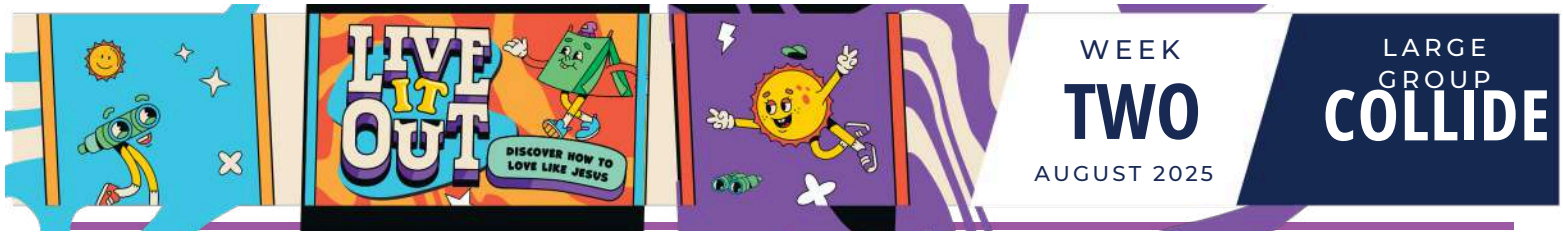
WORSHIP

HOST: I'm so excited to worship with you! Let's worship together

AFTER BIBLE STORY

HOST: “Let me read that verse from Paul again...”

Open the Bible to Colossians 3:13 (NIRV) and read.

“Put up with one another. Forgive one another if you are holding something against someone. Forgive, just as the Lord forgave you.”

“This story is so cool because we just watched what it looked like when the Lord forgives... what it looks like to not hold something against someone. And we are now called to live like Jesus in the way we forgive one another. The example has been set!” Jesus died on the cross to pay for our sins so that we could be forgiven . . . and so that we could have a relationship with God that will last forever! So in response, we can choose to forgive others when they’ve wronged us.”

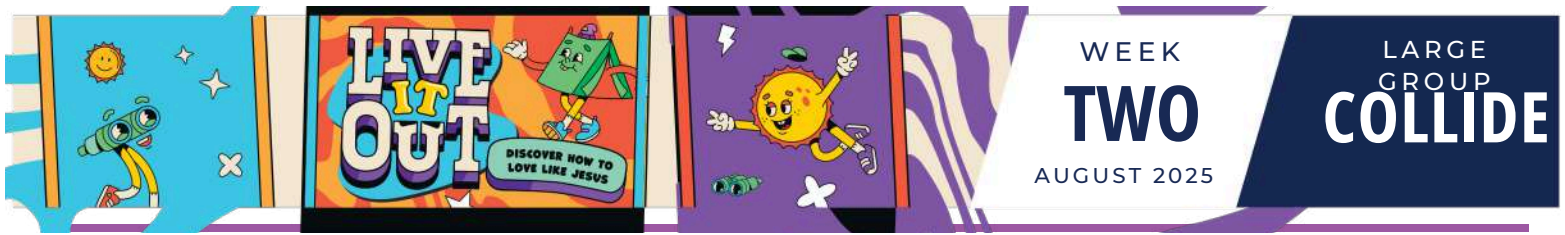
“It can be really easy to keep track of all the things others do wrong to us. The truth is, things happen to us all the time that hurt us and upset us. Some of those things can be silly...like when someone says they don’t like the color of our shoes. Okay, that hurts, but do we want to hold something like that against someone forever and refuse to forgive them? Or do we want to live like Jesus and forgive one another?”

“But some things can be really serious. We saw that with Jesus and Peter. And it can take some time to work through some of the pain that was caused. But if a person is a good friend, it is worth forgiving one another and working through it.”

“Now, there may come a time when you have a friend that hurts you SO bad...that you just can’t be friends with them anymore. And that is okay. You might need wisdom from a trusted godly adult to help you with this. But regardless of what happens, you can still forgive them, because that will help YOU live with peace and freedom even if you don’t ever hang out with that person again.”

“Do you know one of the coolest things about forgiving others? When we are willing to forgive, it is a reminder of what God has done for us. That is what Paul said, right. We forgive, BECAUSE we are...(wait for responses) FORGIVEN! Yes!”

“We have sinned and done so many things that God has asked us not to. But through Jesus, God has forgiven us. He has erased our debt. And when we forgive others, we are acting just like God does. So when we are tempted to hold on to our hurt or to make others pay for what they have done, consider the story of Jesus and Peter, and how you can be more like Jesus in forgiving someone for the wrong they have done. This is how we can live like Jesus!”



HOST: “As you start your craft today, think about this –“

SLIDE: Key Question

“[Key Question] What makes it hard to forgive? I want you to talk about a time where you knew you should forgive someone but it was REALLY difficult. Before you start your craft, let’s pray and ask God to help us live like Jesus in the way we forgive one another!”

SLIDE: Theme Background

Host leads group in a prayer related to what they just heard. After prayer, Host encourages kids to play sword drill.

SLIDE : SWORD DRILL

“Before we start out craft, we’re going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it!

Here’s how we play:

- Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
- I will call out a Bible verse — like 'John 3:16.'
- When I say 'GO!', you’ll race to find that verse in your Bible.
- Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

“We’re going to look for three Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let’s see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it’s not just about speed. It’s about learning how to find God’s Word and hide it in our hearts!
