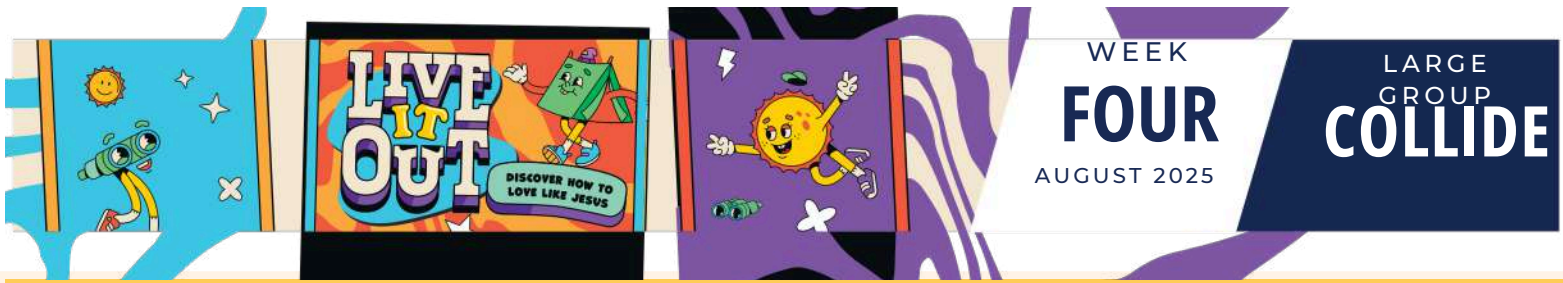

OPENER

HOST: "Roll call campers! How are we all doing? Great to be together today. Welcome to Collide. All summer long, we're finding out what it means to 'Live It Out' or share the love of Jesus with everyone. You can probably name a lot of ways by now! If you know some, shout them out! **Pause for responses.**

"Great job! There are a lot of ways we can show the love of Jesus to others. We'll be finding out how we can 'Live It Out'—in other words, how we can love like Jesus. That's definitely the best way to live!

Now, let's stand and worship together!"

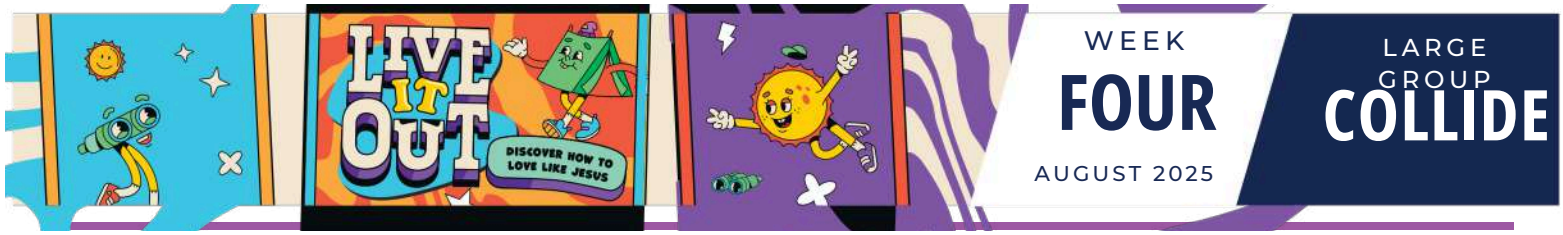
WORSHIP

HOST: "This time to sing to God. Did you know God loves us SO much? We can share that love with others through the words we say and the things we do. Let's sing loud!

AFTER BIBLE STORY

HOST: “In this story, we saw a man literally carry the burden of someone, with the help of a donkey of course. Now, caring for one another may not look like literally carrying someone, but it does look like going out of your way to do MORE than you think. Every day, God will put people in your path that we can show love to just like Jesus would. The question is, will we be a neighbor to them like this story Jesus told?”

“Sometimes, those people in our paths may be quite different from us, like the Samaritan and the Jew...remember oil and water? But that doesn’t change our call to live like Jesus and show we are a neighbor through our actions...to carry one another’s heavy loads. Because when we do...we are loving like Jesus asked us to, which is exactly how Jesus loves.”

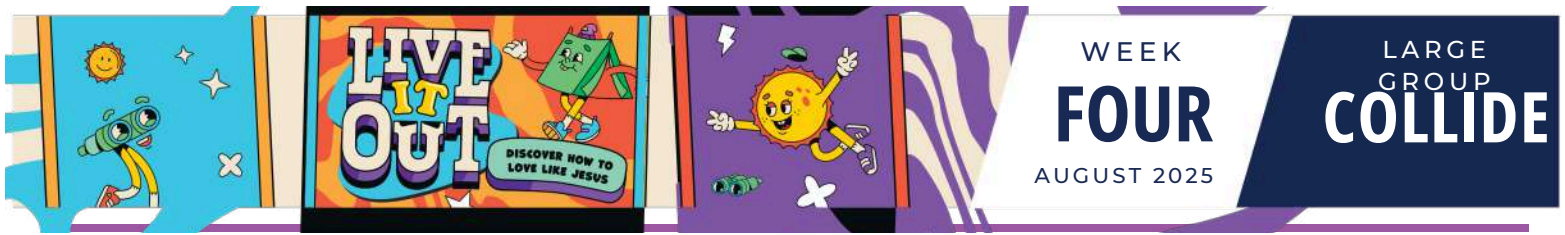
HOST: “As you start your craft today, think about this ...”

SLIDE: Key Question

“[Key Question] How can you show someone you care? I want you to talk about what it looks like to carry one another’s burdens. Where might you encounter a situation like that?’ Before you start, let’s pray and ask God to help us see and love our neighbors through our actions, no matter WHO they are!”

SLIDE: Theme Background

Host leads group in a prayer related to what they just heard. After prayer, Host encourages kids to play sword drill.



SLIDE : SWORD DRILL

“Before we start out craft, we’re going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it!

Here’s how we play:

- Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
- I will call out a Bible verse — like 'John 3:16.'
- When I say 'GO!', you’ll race to find that verse in your Bible.
- Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

“We’re going to look for three Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let’s see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it’s not just about speed. It’s about learning how to find God’s Word and hide it in our hearts!

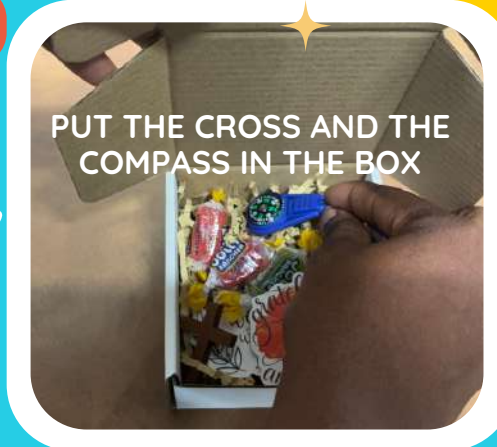

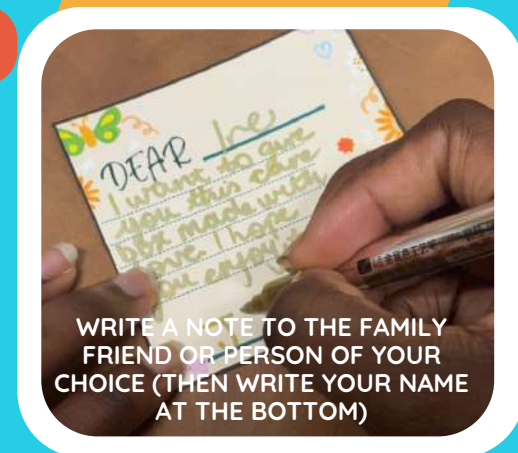

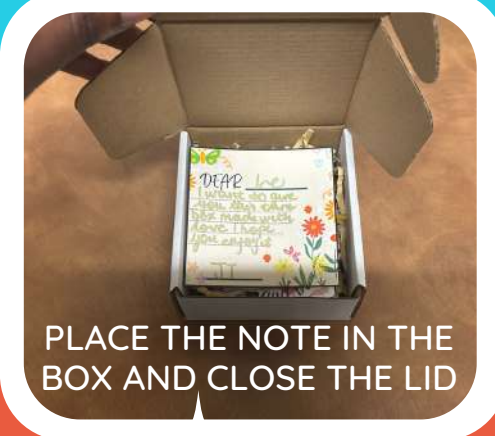
