OPENER

HOST: "Hello, everybody! It's another great day here at camp—I mean Collide. I'm excited to be here with you as we find out how we can 'live it out' and love like Jesus.

And one way we live out God's love is by encouraging the people in our lives. That can make a BIG difference in their lives. It can fill their hearts with hope when they need it most."

Our Memory Verse for this month is Philippians 2:5. Let's say it together

Now, let's all stand and get ready to worship together! Let's sing loud to our amazing God!"

WORSHIP

HOST: "We should think and act as Who did? (Pause for responses.) Right—Jesus. We need to learn how to love like He does. We need help from God's Spirit to be able to show that kind of love to each another.

Now why don't we turn our eyes, ears and hearts towards the screen and watch this week's bible story together.

AFTER BIBLE STORY

HOST: "You know, when the church first started in the early days talked about in the Bible, they didn't really have buildings like we do. Instead, they had people—people who would come together because of their faith in Jesus. And even though our churches often meet together in buildings today, we can't forget that we don't just GO to church . . . we ARE the church. And as we just saw, there is a lot that we need to do as a WE rather than just an I. In other words, to love like Jesus is to live for ONE ANOTHER!

"Sometimes we need ONE ANOTHER because we need to be reminded that our hope is truly in Jesus. Sometimes we need ONE ANOTHER to motivate us to love others when it is hard to love others. Sometimes we need ONE ANOTHER to remind us that it's worth the time to stop and serve others. Sometimes we need to gather with ONE ANOTHER so we can encourage them and be encouraged by them. Sometimes we need to share words of hope with those who are discouraged.

"One amazing way to live like Jesus is to encourage the people around you. We're especially called to encourage others who love Jesus to love LIKE Jesus!"

HOST: "As you start your craft today, think about this.

SLIDE: Key Question

[Key Question] "When has someone encouraged you? Think about a time when you were impacted by the way someone encouraged you. How can that be an example for how you encourage others? This is something you'll get to talk about more with at your table, but before you start your craft, let's pray and ask God to help us be an encouragement to others as we share words of hope!"

SLIDE: Theme Background

Host leads group in a prayer related to what they just heard. After prayer, Host encourages kids to play sword drill







SLIDE: SWORD DRILL

"Before we start out craft, we're going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it!

Here's how we play:

- Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
- I will call out a Bible verse like 'John 3:16.'
- When I say 'GO!', you'll race to find that verse in your Bible.
- Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

"We're going to look for three Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let's see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it's not just about speed. It's about learning how to find God's Word and hide it in our hearts!
