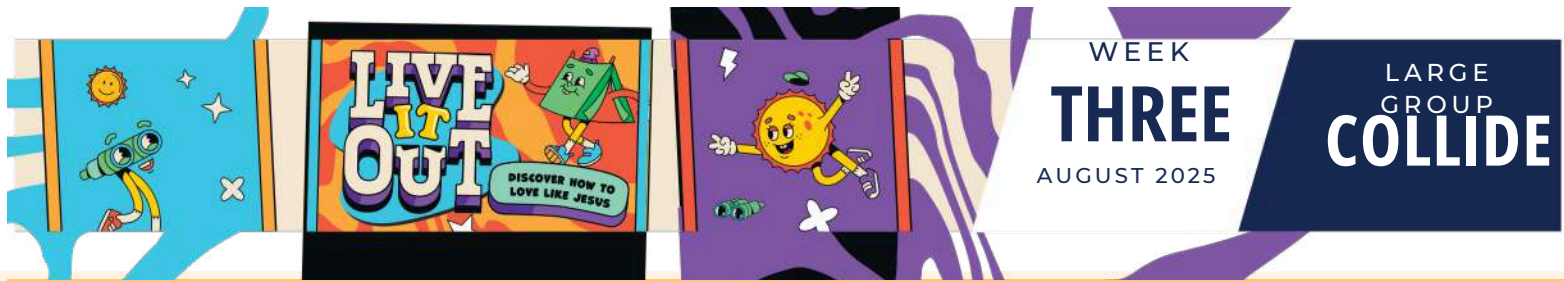

OPENER

Now, let's stand and worship together!"

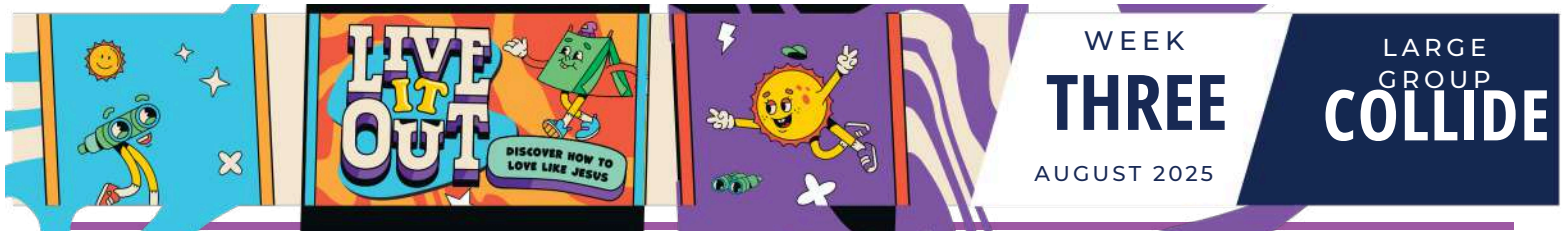
WORSHIP

HOST: "Hello, everyone! I'm so excited to worship with you! Let's worship together and 'Live It Out' together!"

AFTER BIBLE STORY

HOST: “It was a pretty funny moment in the story when Peter’s friends were praying for him, and he showed up right in the middle of their prayer! It was such an unexpected answer to prayer that they didn’t believe it was him! It is like sometimes we can pray and ask God for something without actually believing God is going to do it.”

“If we are learning to live and love like Jesus this summer, there were many times that Jesus prayed for others. He EVEN prayed for His enemies. Peter’s friends prayed for him. Paul reminded us to pray for others. It is like prayer is kind of a big deal or something!”

“You can also pray for others. You might feel like you have to use fancy or important words, but prayer is just opening up your heart to God and telling Him what is going on...which, by the way, He already knows. But like any relationship, your heavenly Father wants you to talk with Him! Maybe He is bringing someone to mind that is going through a hard time. Talk to God about them! Ask God to help them and to be with them. You may not see God unlock prison bars or do something dramatic, but your prayer may bring peace and comfort or wisdom and help. When you see a need, take a moment to pray for one another. That is living and loving like Jesus!”

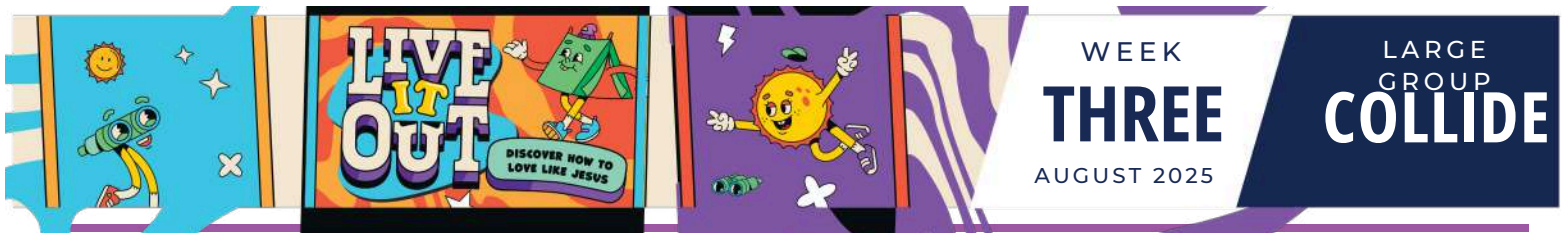
HOST: “As you start your craft today, think about this“

SLIDE: Key Question

“[Key Question] Why is it important to pray? I want you to talk about what prayer is and how we can pray for one another more.’ Before you go, let’s pray and ask God to help us better see how important prayer is...that it really does work!”

SLIDE: Theme Background

Host leads group in a prayer related to what they just heard. After prayer, Host encourages kids to play sword drill.



SLIDE : SWORD DRILL

“Before we start out craft, we’re going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it!

Here’s how we play:

- Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
- I will call out a Bible verse — like 'John 3:16.'
- When I say 'GO!', you’ll race to find that verse in your Bible.
- Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

“We’re going to look for three Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let’s see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it’s not just about speed. It’s about learning how to find God’s Word and hide it in our hearts!

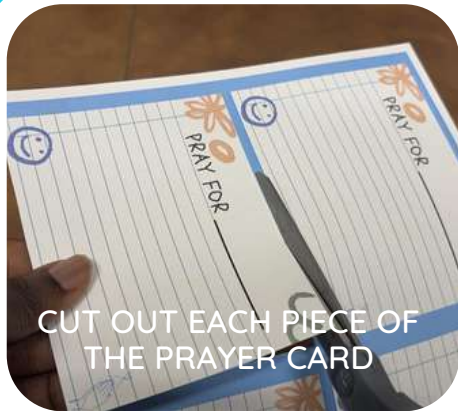

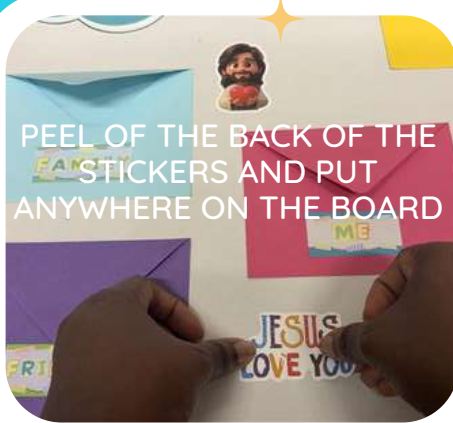
