SLIDE: THEME

COUNTDOWN: 30 SECOND VERSION

WELCOME KIDS:

HOST: "Hello, my friends! It's great to be here with you at Kidz Rock. I'm your Host, [your name], and all summer we're finding out how we can 'Live It Out.' Let me hear you say: 'Live It Out!'

AUDIENCE: "Live It Out!"

HOST: "Yes! 'Live It Out' means that we don't just hear about Jesus and the way He lived. We actually change the way we live our lives. With God's help, we choose to show love like Jesus did. And we can do that in different ways—like living in peace with one another . . . looking out for another . . . and encouraging one another.

"Now it's time to check out our Virtue for this month! Are you ready to shout it out with me?"

SLIDE: VIRTUE

HOST: "It's really cool to think that, With Jesus, we can help change the world.!"

We'll be finding out how we can 'Live It Out'—in other words, how we can love like Jesus. That's definitely the best way to live!

HOST: "It's so amazing to think about the way Jesus lived—how He treated everyone with love and kindness. And if you think about it, it's a huge gift that we get to live like Jesus too, by showing love to the people around us.

"Following Jesus is the very BEST way for us to live. Jesus said, 'I have come so [we] may have life. I want them to have it in the fullest possible way.' (John 10:10, NIrV) That's what this song is about. We can follow Jesus and 'live fully alive.' Sing this with me.

SLIDE: THEME

Are you ready???

Romans 15:7 (Supporting :Acts 10)

WRAPPING UP THE STORY

HOST: "When Cornelius and all his household received the Holy Spirit, God made it clear that Jesus is for everyone! We don't have to agree with everyone, but we can still love and respect them-because everyone is made in God's image.

MEMORY VERSE

Open the Bible to Philippians 2:5 (NIrV) and read.
As you deal with one another, you should think and act as Jesus did. (NIrV)

SLIDE: BOTTOM LINE

"Accept one another. Say that with me."

PRAYER:

"God, thank You giving us this chance to come together and learn more about You. We can see through Peter's story that You've called us to accept one another. Thank You for the way You love us all equally. Teach us how to accept others and how to live like Jesus this week. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."

SLIDE: SWORD DRILL

"Before we head over to the craft table, we're going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it!

Here's how we play:

- 1. Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
- 2.1 will call out a Bible verse like 'John 3:16.'
- 3. When I say 'GO!', you'll race to find that verse in your Bible.
- 4. Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

"We're going to look for Five Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let's see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it's not just about speed. It's about learning how to find God's Word and hide it in our hearts!
