SLIDE: THEME

COUNTDOWN: 30 SECOND VERSION

WELCOME KIDS:

HOST: "Hi, everyone! It's great to be here with you at Kidz Rock. This summer we're finding out what it means to 'Live It Out' and share the love of Jesus. We've talked about several ways to do that so far—and I'll give you a hint. They all end with 'one another.' Anyone have any ideas? (*Pause for responses.*)

"We can love like Jesus by living in peace with one another... by looking out for one another... by <u>encouraging one another</u>... and <u>by accepting one another</u>.

There are lots more ways too, which we can read about in the Bible. (Hold up Bible.) We'll talk about a really important one today.

"But first, it's time for us to check out our Virtue for this month! Are you ready to shout it out with me?"

SLIDE: VIRTUE

"With Jesus, we can help change the world."

We'll be finding out how we can 'Live It Out'—in other words, how we can love like Jesus. That's definitely the best way to live!

HOST: "I love worshipping God with all of you. We're not just singing because we like music or because we like to dance. We're telling everyone around us how amazing God is! This song says, 'At the top of my lungs I'll sing. With all of my heart I will praise You.' Let's lift our voices and honor God now. Here we go!

SLIDE: THEME

"Do you know that God is with us, and he wants to speak to us through His Word? So let's get ready to hear a true story from the Bible. Open your ears as big as you can—like elephant ears!—so you can hear God's Word really well. After we watch the Bible story, I'm going to ask you some fun questions. So listen closely! Are you ready???

BIBLE STORY LAB:

I Think it's About...Forgiveness Forgive One Another/Jesus Forgives Peter Colossians 3:13 (Supporting: John 13:36-38; 21:1-19)

TALK IT OUT - Quesion & Answer!

- ☐ Who told Peter and his friends to throw the net on the right side of the boat?
- → Jesus
- ☐ Who did Jesus ask Peter?
- → Do you love me?
- ☐ How many times did Jesus ask Peter, "Do you love me?"
- → Three times
- □ Did Jesus forgive Peter even though he made mistakes?
- → Yes
- ☐ What should we do when someone does something wrong to us?
- → Forgive them, like Jesus forgives us

WRAPPING UP THE STORY

HOST: "Wow! I love what Paul wrote in his letter: 'Forgive, just as the Lord forgave you' (Colossians 3:13). It reminds me how of Jesus forgave His friend Peter . . . and how Jesus forgives US too.

Jesus died on the cross to pay for our sins so that we could be forgiven . . . and so that we could have a relationship with God that will last forever! So in response, we can choose to forgive others when they've wronged us.


MEMORY VERSE

Open the Bible to Roman 15:5 (NIrV) and read.

Our God is a God who strengthens and encourages you. May he gives you the same attitude toward one another that Christ Jesus had. (NIrV)

"Let's all stand up and recite the Memory Verse!

"This is what we need to remember today:









SLIDE: BOTTOM LINE

"Forgive One Another. Say that with me."

PRAYER:

"God, it's so amazing to think about what You've done for us by sending Jesus to be our Savior. Jesus died on the cross and made a way for us to be forgiven . . . and we are so thankful, God. We can also see how Jesus showed forgiveness in the way He treated His friend Peter. Please show us how we can forgive people when they've wronged us. That can be really, really difficult, and it might even feel impossible. God, would You guide us to show Your love with the way we treat the people around us? We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."

SLIDE: SWORD DRILL

"Before we head over to the craft table, we're going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it! Here's how we play:

- 1. Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
- 2.1 will call out a Bible verse like 'John 3:16.'
- 3. When I say 'GO!', you'll race to find that verse in your Bible.
- 4. Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

"We're going to look for Five Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let's see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it's not just about speed. It's about learning how to find God's Word and hide it in our hearts!

SWORD DRILL VERSES

1st Round: Colossians 3:13 (NIrV)

• "Put up with one another. Forgive one another if you are holding something against someone. Forgive, just as the Lord forgave you."

2nd Round: John 13:38 (NIrV)

• Jesus answered, "Before the rooster crows, you will say three times that you don't know me!"

3rd Round: John 21:17 (NIrV)


• Jesus said, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" Peter said, "Lord, you know all things. You know that I love you!" Jesus said, "Feed my sheep."

4th Round: Ephesians 4:32 (NIrV)

• "Be kind and tender to one another. Forgive each other, just as God forgave you because of what Christ has done.."

5th Round: Matthew 4:19 (NIrV)

• "Come and follow me, " Jesus said. "I will send you out to fish for people."











SLIDE: August Week 2 Craft
