
**SLIDE: VIRTUE**

# **SLIDE: THEME**

Are you ready???

# **TALK IT OUT - Quesion & Answer!**

☐ Who can we talk to when we pray?

(Answer: God)

□ What happened to Peter when he was in jail?
(Answer: An angel came and helped him escape.)
□ Where did Peter go to after he got out of prison?

(Answer: Mary's house / His friends)

☐ What did Peter's friends do while he was in jail?

(Answer: They prayed for him.)

#### WRAPPING UP THE STORY

**HOST:** "In the morning, the guards couldn't figure out what had happened to Peter. But Peter's friends got to see how powerful prayer is.

"Just like Peter's friends and all the early Jesus-followers... we are called to pray for each other —at anytime, anywhere, about anything.


#### **MEMORY VERSE**

Open the Bible to Roman 15:5 (NIrV) and read.

Our God is a God who strengthens and encourages you. May he gives you the same attitude toward one another that Christ Jesus had. (NIrV)

"Let's all stand up and recite the Memory Verse!

### **SLIDE: BOTTOM LINE**

"Pray for one another. Say that with me."

#### **PRAYER:**

"God, thank You so much for all that You do for us. Help us as we learn to pray for others. God, help us find people who we can pray for. Help us know how to help others and how we can show Your love to them. We

love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."

# **SLIDE: SWORD DRILL**

"Before we head over to the craft table, we're going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it! <u>Here's how we play:</u>

- 1. Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
- 2.1 will call out a Bible verse like 'John 3:16.'
- 3. When I say 'GO!', you'll race to find that verse in your Bible.
- 4. Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

"We're going to look for Five Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let's see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it's not just about speed. It's about learning how to find God's Word and hide it in our hearts!

# **SWORD DRILL VERSES**

1st Round: 1 Timothy 2:1

"First, I want you to pray for all people. Ask God to help and bless them. Give thanks for them."

2<sup>nd</sup> Round: Acts 12:5

"So Peter was kept in prison. But the church was praying hard to God for him."

3<sup>rd</sup> Round: Psalm 34:17

"Godly people cry out, and the LORD hears them. He saves them from all their troubles."

4<sup>th</sup> Round: Philippians 4:6

"Don't worry about anything. Instead, tell God about everything. Ask and pray. Give thanks to him."

5<sup>th</sup> Round: James 5:16

"So confess your sins to one another. Pray for one another so that you might be healed. The prayer of a godly person is powerful. Things happen because of it."
