SLIDE : THEME

COUNTDOWN : 30 SECOND VERSION

WELCOME KIDS :

HOST: “What’s up, everyone?! Welcome to [name of your environment]. All summer long, we’re finding out what it means to ‘Live It Out’ or share the love of Jesus with everyone. You can probably name a lot of ways by now! If you know some, shout them out!

Pause for responses.

“Great job! There are a lot of ways we can show the love of Jesus to others, but before we get into that, let’s check out our Virtue for this month! Are you ready to shout it out with me?”

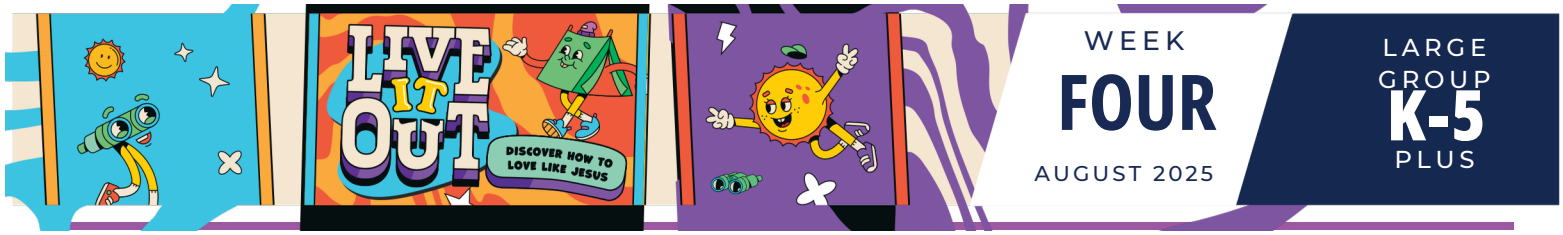
SLIDE : VIRTUE

“With Jesus, we can help change the world.”

We’ll be finding out how we can ‘Live It Out’—in other words, how we can love like Jesus. That’s definitely the best way to live!

HOST: “I love worshipping God with all of you. We’re not just singing because we like music or because we like to dance. We’re telling everyone around us how amazing God is! This song says, ‘At the top of my lungs I’ll sing. With all of my heart I will praise You.’ Let’s lift our voices and honor God now. Here we go!

SLIDE : THEME

“Do you know that God is with us, and he wants to speak to us through His Word?

So let’s get ready to hear a true story from the Bible. Open your ears as big as you can—like elephant ears!—so you can hear God’s Word really well. After we watch the Bible story, I’m going to ask you some fun questions. So listen closely! Are you ready???

BIBLE STORY LAB:

TALK IT OUT - Question & Answer!

□ What is a parable?

(Answer: A short story that teaches a lesson.)

□ What happened to the man on the road?

(Answer: He got hurt.)

□ Who helped the hurt man?

(Answer: The Samaritan man.)

□ What did the Samaritan do to help?

(Answer: He bandaged his wounds and took him to an inn.)

□ What does Jesus want us to do?

(Answer: Care for one another.)

WRAPPING UP THE STORY

HOST:“Jesus’ parable made it clear that our neighbor is not just people who live near us, but anyone we meet who needs our help. Let’s look back at that truth Paul wrote to the Jesus-followers in Galatia.

Open the Bible to Galatians 6:2 (NIRV) and read.

Carry one another’s heavy loads. If you do, you will fulfill the law of Christ.

“This is how we can ‘Live It Out,’ like Jesus.

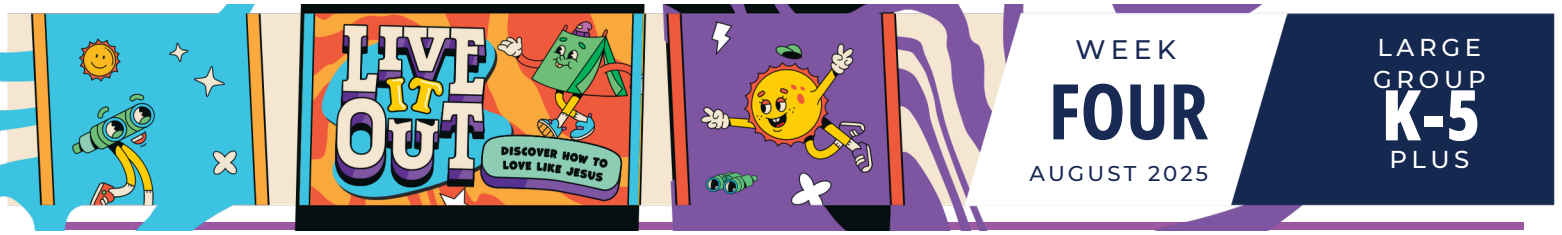
MEMORY VERSE

Open the Bible to Roman 15:5 (NIRV) and read.

Our God is a God who strengthens and encourages you. May he give you the same attitude toward one another that Christ Jesus had. (NIRV)

“Let’s all stand up and recite the Memory Verse!

SLIDE : BOTTOM LINE

“We can care for one another”

PRAYER :

“God, thank You so much for all that You do for us. Help us as we learn to pray for others. God, help us find people who we can pray for. Help us know how to help others and how we can show Your love to them. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus’ name. Amen.”

SLIDE : SWORD DRILL

“Before we head over to the craft table, we’re going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it!

Here’s how we play:

1. Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
2. I will call out a Bible verse — like 'John 3:16.'
3. When I say '**GO!**', you’ll race to find that verse in your Bible.
4. Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

“We’re going to look for Five Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let’s see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it’s not just about speed. It’s about learning how to find God’s Word and hide it in our hearts!

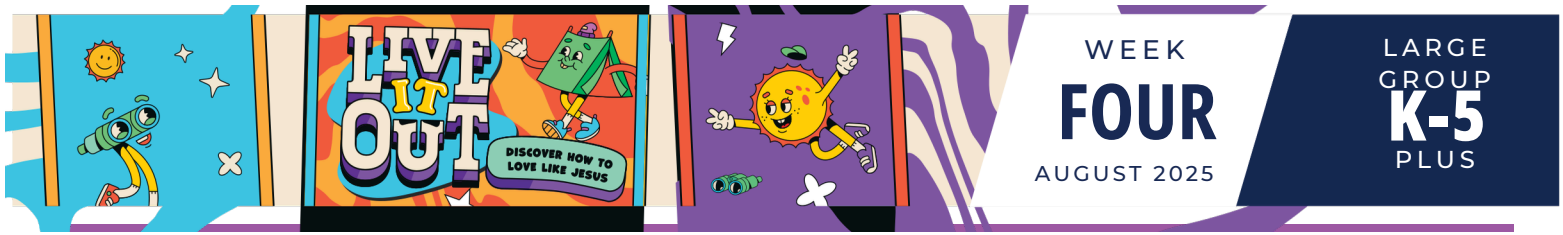
