WELCOME KIDS

HOST: "Hey, hey, everyone! I'm your Host, [your name], and I am pumped for another day of summer camp fun.

"This summer we're finding out how we can live like Jesus and show His love. That means not just talking about Jesus, but living the way He taught us to live. That's how we 'live it out'!

"And here's the thing. There are lots of ways to love like Jesus. Last week we talked about how we can show love by living in peace with one another. Today we'll look at another way we can show Jesus' love, along with another great example from the Bible.!

"Before we dive into today's lesson, let's read today's Virtue together.


SLIDE: VIRTUE

With Jesus, we can help change the world.

We'll be finding out how we can 'Live It Out'—in other words, how we can love like Jesus. That's definitely the best way to live!

HOST: "I want to 'live it out,' I want to find out how to love like Jesus . . . because that's the very best way to live. When we live like Jesus taught us, we are FULLY alive. That's what this song is about. It says, 'I see the way You live. I see the way You love.' Let's sing it!

SLIDE: THEME

"Do you know that God is with us, and he wants to speak to us through His Word? So let's get ready to hear a true story from the Bible.

BIBLE STORY LAB:

I'll Be There for You Look Out for One Another/ Jesus Heals on the Sabbath Philippians 2:4 (Supporting: Luke 6:6-11)

TALK IT OUT!

Ask questions related to the Bible Story! (Questions will be given.)

WRAPPING UP THE STORY

"This was an amazing miracle. You'd think everyone in the room would be rejoicing—and I'm sure a lot of them were. But not the religious leaders. They got ANGRY, because they thought Jesus had done 'work' by healing on the Sabbath.

"Of course, Jesus hadn't actually done anything wrong. He didn't break God's law about the Sabbath, but He did break the extra rules those leaders had made. And they did not like it. "Jesus chose to ignore their extra rules in order to care for a man who was hurting and to make him well. While the religious leaders only cared about making themselves look good, Jesus showed love.

MEMORY VERSE

Open the Bible to Philippians 2:5 (NIrV) and read.

As you deal with one another, you should think and act as Jesus did. (NIrV)


"Let's all stand up and recite the Memory Verse!

SLIDE: SWORD DRILL

"Before we head over to the craft table, we're going to play a fun game called Sword Drill! The Bible is sometimes called the 'sword of the Spirit,' and in this game, we get to practice using it!

Here's how we play:

- Everyone holds their Bible closed and straight up in the air.
- I will call out a Bible verse like 'John 3:16.'
- When I say 'GO!', you'll race to find that verse in your Bible.
- Once you find it, stand up and read it out loud.

"We're going to look for Five Bible verses today. For each verse, the first person to find it, stand up, and read it out loud will be the winner! Each winner gets to come up to the stage and choose a prize from the treasure box!

Let's see who can find the verse the fastest — but remember, it's not just about speed. It's about learning how to find God's Word and hide it in our hearts!

BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

1. WHAT DAY DID JESUS HEAL THE MAN ON?

Answer: The Sabbath.

Please briefly remind kids that it was a special day of rest.

2. WHO DID JESUS HEAL ON THE SABBATH DAY?

Answer: A man with a twisted or hurt hand

3. WHAT WERE JESUS' FRIENDS DOING IN THE GRAIN FIELD?

Answer: Picking and eating grain

3. DID JESUS BREAK GOD'S RULE OR THE EXTRA RULES THE LEADERS MADE UP?

Answer: He didn't break God's rule—just the leaders' extra rules

4. WHAT DOES JESUS WANT US TO DO FOR OTHER PEOPLE?

Answer: Look out for them and show love.



> How to Plays

1. EXPLAIN THE RULES:

- HOLD THE BIBLE UP IN THE AIR.
- WAIT UNTIL THE LEADER SAYS THE FULL BIBLE REFERENCE BEFORE OPENING.
- FIRST ONE TO FIND THE VERSE STANDS UP AND READS IT ALOUD (OR SHOWS IT TO A LEADER IF THEY CAN'T READ FLUENTLY).
- THE WINNER GOES UPON THE STAGE AND PICKS UP THE PRIZE.

2. RUN 5 ROUNDS:

- YOU WILL PLAY 5 ROUNDS OF SWORD DRILL.
- FOR EACH ROUND, CALL OUT A DIFFERENT BIBLE VERSE.
- THE BIBLE VERSES FÓR EACH ROUND WILL BE PROVIDED TO YOU IN ADVANCE.
- KIDS WILL RACE TO FIND THE VERSE IN THEIR BIBLES AS QUICKLY AS THEY CAN.

3. GIVE PRIZES:

- EACH ROUND WINNER GETS TO PICK FROM THE TREASURE BOX.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE THE WINNER PUTS THEIR PRIZE INTO THE CORRECT ZIPLOC BAG
