Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle with your child and pray: "God, them and say: "Good morning! It's almost Jesus' birthday, and I am SO excited!"

Drive Time

While on the go, look for circles. Circles make us think of floofy sheep. Talk about how the shepherds ran to see baby Jesus after an angel told them Jesus had been born.



Bath Time

Let your child wear a party hat during bath time and celebrate Jesus' birthday. Add pom-poms and pretend they are confetti. Toss them in the air as you say: "Happy birthday, Jesus!"
