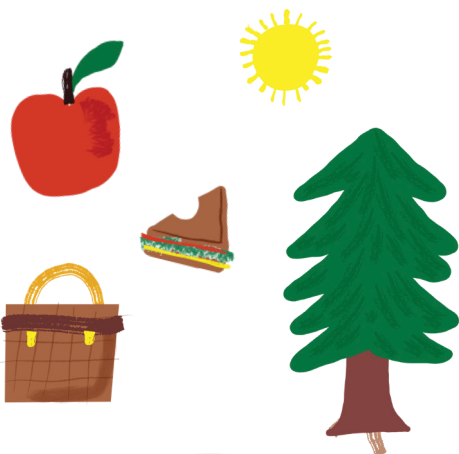


I can thank God for everything.

Prayer

Weekly Parent Cues



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Before we get up, let's thank God for our friends. Thank You, God, for [take turns naming friends]."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, I will give thanks to You with my whole heart for my friends. Thank You for [name friends]."



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your child what they like to do with their friends. Talk about how in the Bible, Daniel asked his friends, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, to pray with him, and they did!



Bath Time

Tell your child to pick three bath time friends to add to bath time. As your child plays with their toy friends, talk about how in the Bible, a man named Daniel had three friends. Daniel's three friends prayed with Daniel when he needed help, and we can pray with our friends too!
