

# Preschool ENGAGE INEVERYDAYMOMENTS TOGETHER



#### **Morning Time**

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Show me a big smile if Jesus wants to be your friend forever. I'm smiling! Let me see you smile too!"



#### **Cuddle Time**

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, [child's name] and I want to thank You for sending Jesus to show us that we are forgiven. Like Peter, sometimes we make the wrong choice. It's so good to know that we can always talk to Jesus about it, and Jesus still loves us and forgives us."



## **Drive Time**

While on the go, talk about when each of you have been afraid of something. Say: "Peter was afraid when people asked him ifyour child plays, ask them what they like when he did that because he really loved says for us to forgive one another."



#### **Bath Time**

Tell your child to pick some of their favorite toy friends to add to bath time. As he knew Jesus, so he said no. Peter was sadabout each toy. Then say: "You like these toy friends a lot, but guess what! Jesus Jesus, but Jesus forgave Peter. Now Jesus loves you even MORE, and Jesus wants to be your real friend FOREVER!"
