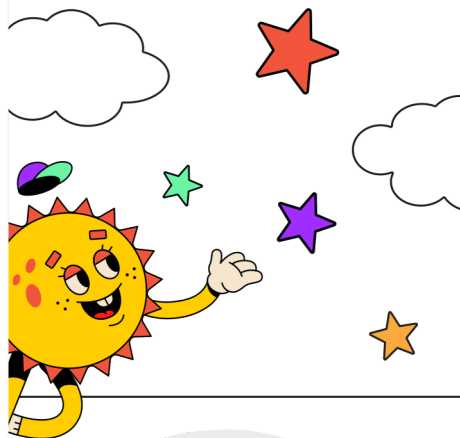


# I can do what Jesus says.

## Morning Time

When you go into your child's room,  
cuddle them and say: "Good morning,  
[child's name]! It's time to wake up  
and be kind and loving to each other!"



## Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear  
God, we have been talking about the  
story Jesus told about the Good  
Samaritan. Please help [child's name]  
and me be kind and loving, like the  
Samaritan man, and stop to care for  
people when they need help."



## Drive Time

While on the go, talk about how God  
made people different, and that's a  
good thing! Jesus wants us to love  
and care for everyone, even people  
who are different from us, just like  
the Good Samaritan.



## Bath Time

Add a doctor's kit and some toy friends  
to bath time. Encourage your child to  
care for the friends as you talk about  
how the Samaritan man stopped to  
care for the hurt man and his boo-boos.
