## **Agenda**

**1. Take down the Piecemakers display and put up the Advent display. (banners at Roseville)** The four banners were hung in Linden Court using the order that was given to us by the worship committee: Hope, Peace, Joy, Love. The items from the Piecemakers display were returned to the Piecemakers storage area in the choir room. The items that are currently at SAP will be returned next week.

### **2. Permanent quilt display**

We hung the wooden Piecemakers sign on the wall at the entrance to Linden Court. The red quilt is also still there. Tammy will email Peggy Rhodes to let her know that the Piecemakers Group can use that wall as they see fit. They may leave the items there, or take them down, or switch to different items.

**3. Make a plan for getting the Ornament display up at SAP (before church on the 30th?)** Tammy and Roy (and anyone else who wants to help) will meet at SAP at 10:00AM this Sunday, November 30th to hang the ornaments. Roy has a stand for his ornament. It will sit on the table.

**4. Donated Picture from Jim and Jan House** We viewed the picture and all agreed that we will keep it. A photo was taken to add to the record book. There is a card tucked in the back of the frame that says it was painted by Barbara Coss. It is now in the storage room. Tammy will write a thank you card to Jim and Jan House.

**5. Do we need a more clear policy on how to manage acquisitions and donations?**  
No. Our policy is that each time something is donated, we will review it at our next meeting and decide if we will keep it or not. Our decision will be based on these two questions: Does it fit our mission? Do we have a space for it?

**6. Report on the "Our Future Together" meeting that Tammy attended to represent our team.** Tammy Nara and Chris Rhode met with the architects about the needs and responsibilities of our committee. We told him that our storage space is sufficient. We pointed out pieces of art that are important to honor, like the Red Robin statue and the wall of past clergy. We said it is important to have a place to display art and that the art on permanent display needs to reflect the values of the church.

**7. Future Displays:** Roy's nephew, Kevin DuCharme, may be a future artist to feature. His website is [artavistudio.com](http://artavistudio.com). Tammy will ask an artist she knows, James Nutt, if he wants to do a display of the art he made while on the [Camino pilgrimage trail in Spain](#). Another future idea is to take photos to document the changes happening in the church once a decision is made and construction/remodeling/moving starts to happen.

We decided that **for the time between Christmas and Lent, we will spotlight pieces from our permanent collection at both campuses**. There are pieces in the Roseville storage closet that should have a turn to be seen. There are photos and prints in the office hallway at SAP that many people never get a chance to see.

**8. Today is Steve Rhode's last meeting.** We thanked Steve for his service. He will still be available to answer questions in his role as Centennial Facilities Coordinator.

**9. Other New Business:** Tammy plans on staying on as committee chair until summer 2027. That will be a 3 year term.
