1. Take down the current display and put up the quilts.

We looked at all the pieces that were left for us by the Piecemakers group and selected some to be displayed at Roseville and some to be displayed at SAP. The pieces we decided not to use were put back in one of the plastic tubs and returned to the choir room closet. The other plastic tub was packed with the pieces for SAP and Tammy will bring them there on September 21 at 9:45 to put up before the service. Barb, JD, and maybe Tom will also be there. Tammy printed the write-up about the Piecemakers group, and Tom brought a photo that they shared with him. Peggy Rhodes asked that the write up include the upcoming sale. Since our group does not promote art sales, the write-up says that the next chance to see the quilts will be at the UWF brunch in December.

2. Decide if we want a permanent quilt display in the spot Steve suggested in an earlier email

We selected a quilt to hang on the short wall next to the door between Linden Court and the hallway. We will decide at our next meeting if it stays up when we take the other quilts down.

3. Report on Park and Ride and discussion about our funds

One question was about documentation of the donated picture near the Asbury rooms. We found it in the more recent 3 ring binder. Another question was about a picture from Lyngblomsten. We found it in the storage closet. Barb was at the table at SAP and Tammy joined her there part way through the event. We also talked with many people there, but no one added their name to our list.

4. Future display ideas. The idea of displaying photos from the Youth Mission Trip did not materialize. Should we continue to pursue that idea or choose a different one?

We are moving on from the idea of having photos from the Youth trip, but are still open to it if asked by the Youth group. For Advent, we will do the same thing we did last year, hang the Advent banners at Roseville and ask the SAP congregation to bring ornaments from home. At SAP, participants will have the option of writing a short description of why that ornament is important to them.

We will decide at the next meeting what to display after Christmas. We talked about spotlighting other groups in our church. We also talked about some local artists that might be good choices. All committee members were encouraged to keep thinking about this and bring ideas to the next meeting.

5. The Church has an app that some groups use to communicate. Should we use that for our communication or stick with email?

All committee members agreed that continuing to communicate via email is best. We will revisit this as needed.
