The Bible says in (Philippians 3:13-14) “Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.”

So let go of yesterday and walk on, because the Lord who walks with you is greater than anything you left behind. Aren't you glad that the same God who carried you through the past up to the year 2025 now walks beside you into a future of a New Year 2026 that is filled with His promises.

Yet this new year also brings a challenge. Paul said, “I press toward the mark.” Pressing implies effort, discipline, and intentional faith. A new year will not automatically bring spiritual growth. It comes when we choose to pray more earnestly, to trust Him more deeply, to forgive more freely, and obey more completely. As we step into this new year, let us ask ourselves:

- Am I willing to let go of what God has already forgiven?
- Am I willing to move forward even when the future feels uncertain?
- Am I willing to press on when faith demands perseverance?

The same God who brought you through the past year will walk with you into the next one. He goes before you, stands beside you, and remains faithful behind you. Whatever this year holds, hold tightly to Him.

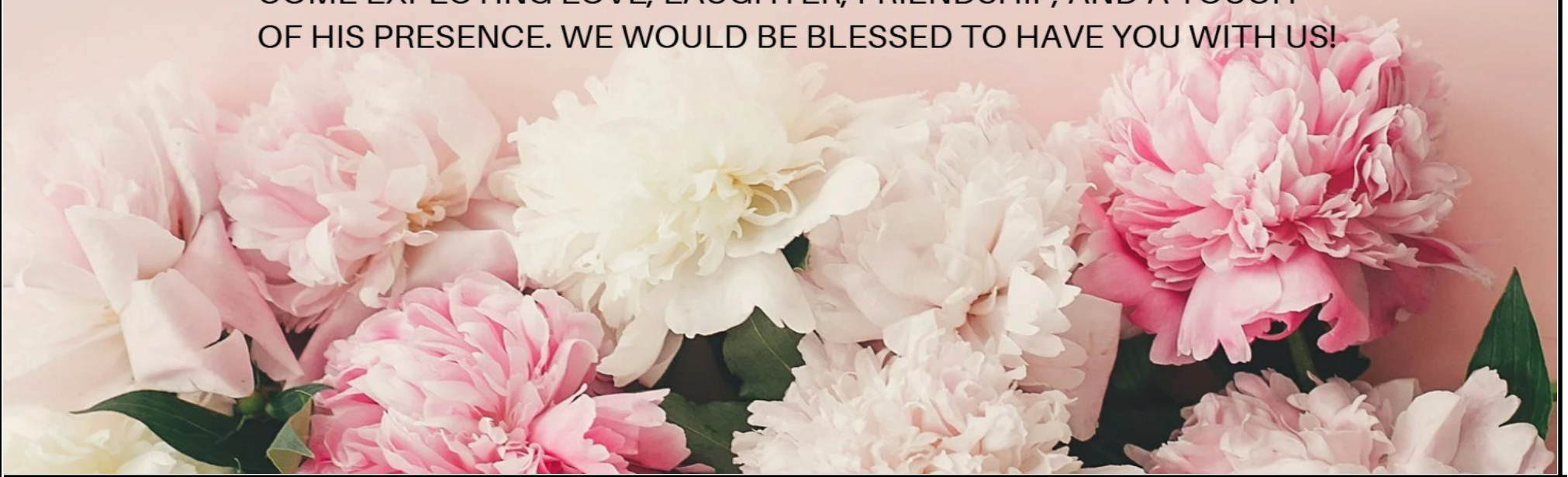

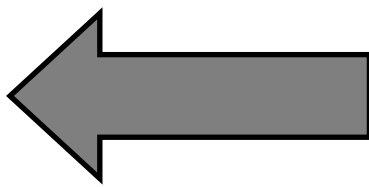
