The Road Ends and Begins in Bethlehem

I. Slide1a Announce:

- A. Welcome to those watching online 1pm. Out in Fellowship Hall or LC.
- B. Prayer:

II. Intro:

- A. The Road Ends (and Begins) in Bethlehem.
- B. For the last 6 weeks we've been walking together on *the long road* to Bethlehem.
 - 1. A road of promise, preparation, surrender, obedience, wonder, worship.
 - 2. But it doesn't just **end** at Bethlehem it **opens** a brand-new road for the world. Christmas is both God's **Arrival** to us, and His **Invitation** for us.
- C. The 1st Christmas is a <u>hinge</u> moment: Everything <u>before</u> points to Bethlehem; everything <u>after</u> flows from it. [Bethlehem isn't a <u>finish line</u>; it's a <u>doorway</u>]
- D. The **manger** says something shocking: God didn't wait for <u>us</u> to **climb up**, **He** came down. Christmas is not about <u>us</u> finding God, it's about <u>God</u> finding <u>us</u>.
- E. See, God Wrapped Hope in a **Promise**.
 - 1. The 1st Christmas wasn't a *surprise party*, it was the <u>unveiling</u> of a **promise** God had been *slowly* <u>un</u>wrapping since Eden.
- F. Slide1b The Power of a Wrapped Gift. [*hold blue box]
- G. Christmas Eve is about *Anticipation*. There's something about a wrapped gift even before it's opened.
 - 1. You don't know exactly what's inside. But <u>you know</u> ...
 Someone **thought** about you. Someone **planned**. Someone **prepared**.
 - 2. And the longer a gift sits under the tree, the more meaningful it becomes.
- H. What if I told you **the very first Christmas gift didn't** sit under a tree <u>for days</u> ... It sat under **the story of humanity** *for thousands of years*.

- 1. Slide1c **This gift** was **not** like Amazon's *next Day Delivery*! [nope not until *The fullness of time had come /* not until the right time *set by* the Father]
- 2. Christmas wasn't God *improvising*. It was God unveiling a gift He had been wrapping since the beginning. [Let's *reenact* the slow unveiling]

III. Slide2 1 THE GIFT ANNOUNCED [set box down]

- A. Gen. 3:15 He (Jesus) shall bruise your head (satan), and you (satan) shall bruise His heel (Jesus)
 - 1. The world was just broken. Sin had entered. Shame, fear, separation ... all rush in. And right there (*not after* humanity cleans itself up) God speaks.
 - 2. This is *the very first whisper* of the gospel. A promise of a Child. A promise of a Victor. A promise that *evil* will not have *the final word*.
 - a) God didn't <u>wait for us</u> to find hope ... He announced Hope Himself.
- B. Visual: [hold up the first wrapped layer] This is where God started <u>un</u>wrapping the **gift**. Hope spoken into a *hopeless* moment. [open up blue]

IV. Slide3 2 THE GIFT DESCRIBED

- A. Isaiah 7:14 The virgin shall conceive & bear a son, and shall call His name Immanuel.
- B. Now the wrapping gets more detailed. God doesn't just say a rescuer *Is* coming He says *How* He's coming.
 - 1. A virgin. A son. Immanuel (God with us). This is huge ...
 - Not God <u>shouting</u> instructions from heaven. Not God <u>sending</u> another prophet. God <u>Himself</u> is coming!
 - a) The promise of Christmas isn't just *rescue* it's **presence**!
- C. Visual: [*Pick up Silver] Unwrap the second layer.
 - 1. God lets His people *peek at the gift*. Not fully opened, but clearly promised.
- V. Slide4 **3 THE GIFT DELIVERED** [*Brian that's a poor wrap job ... I know!]

- A.Micah 5:2/Mt.2:6 And you, O **Bethlehem** ... for a ruler will come from you who will be the shepherd for my people Israel.
- B. Now the wrapping has a label Not Jerusalem. Not Rome. Not a palace ...
 - 1. Bethlehem. Small. Overlooked. Ordinary ... and that's the point!
 - a) Gift Tag says ... To: Bethlehem. From: The Father.
 - 2. Oh and God wrapped the greatest gift in the Humblest Packaging.
- C. Visual: Kids have you guessed what the gift was from God? unwrap the final box to reveal *Jesus in the manger*.
 - 1. What God promised ... He delivered!
- D. Slide5a The Meaning of the Gift.
- E. This gift wasn't wrapped in *gold*. It was wrapped in flesh.
 - 1. Not placed on a throne, placed in a feeding trough. Not admired from a distance, given to be received.
 - 2. The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. Jn.1:14
 - a) Christmas is proof that: God keeps His Promises. God enters our Mess. God comes close!
- F. Slide5b*Thanks be to **God** for <u>His *Indescribable* gift!</u> Do you know where that shows up?
 - 1. 2nd Corinth. After a long discussion on giving and generosity (ch's 8,9).
 - a) Paul wraps up both ch's with that statement.
 - 2. Slide6a Paul seems to have coined Indescribable, (not in NT, nor in the Gk OT).
 - a) Inexpressible gift (esv); Too wonderful for words (nlt); No language can praise it enough (msg). [Paul is confessing *inadequacy*]
 - (1) This one word protects us from 2 dangers: Reducing the gospel to *slogans*. Losing awe through *over-familiarity*.
 - b) This Gift from heaven is Unutterable. Indescribable. Unquantifiable. Undefinable. Incommunicable. Ineffable. Unspeakable.

3. All of it wrapped in *the plan of God* in giving us His Son ... *His Indescribable Gift.*

G. Slide6b Personal Application

- H. Some of us tonight are carrying: *disappointment. unanswered prayers. long seasons of waiting.*
 - 1. And Christmas whispers this truth: If God kept His promise then... He can be trusted **Now!**
- I. The same God who wrapped Hope through centuries, is still working in the waiting rooms of our lives.
- J. Slide6c Invitation: Every road demands a response! The shepherds went. The wise men followed. Mary said yes. Joseph obeyed.
 - 1. Will you <u>stay</u> where you are, <u>or step onto the road</u> God has opened? See, the road begins *wherever a heart turns toward Jesus*.
 - 2. The road to Bethlehem <u>ends</u> at a manger, **but** the road of *following* **Jesus** <u>begins</u> there!
- K. **Tonight**, the road has led <u>all of us</u> **to** Bethlehem. But the real question is ... What will <u>you</u> do with **Jesus**?
 - 1. If tonight you sense God **inviting you** to **step onto** that new road ... To receive His forgiveness, His grace, and new life.
 - 2. To Trust and Follow Jesus, to receive His free gift, Salvation.
 - 3. I want to invite you to raise your hand in a moment. This is simply you saying, **Jesus**, I want to **follow** You.
