

TRIP ITINERARY



DAY 1 - APRIL 20,21

Flight & arrival in Tel Aviv

Depart from LAX to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals will be served in flight. You will arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv. Then we'll head to your hotel in on the Mediterranean, where you will enjoy a good night's sleep.

DAY 2 - APRIL 22

After a great Israeli Breakfast, we'll continue to Maritime Caesarea and to Mount Carmel (1 Kings 18) to hear about the Prophet Elijah. At noon, enjoy a typical Israeli lunch such as Falafel. Your next stop is Megiddo, Biblical Armageddon (1 Kings 9:15, Rev. 6:16). From there onto Nazareth. Then dinner and accommodation at the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 3 - APRIL 23

Head North and to the Galilee

After breakfast, Sea of Galilee, visit the Mount of Beatitudes, then to Capernaum, Tabgha, and Korazim. Magdala Synagogue.

DAY 4 - APRIL 24

A Day in Galilee

Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Mnt. Bental in the Golan Heights. Gadarenes. Yardenit (Baptismal site). Go on a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 5 - APRIL 25

Depart Galilee for Qumran/Salt Sea

Departing the Galilee to visit Beit Shean. Then via Jordan Valley to Win Harod, then head down to the Dead Sea and float before dinner time.

DAY 6 - APRIL 26

Masada and En Gedi

In the morning, climb by cable car to visit Masada (Herod's fortress and last point of Jewish resistance against the Romans). Hike up Ein Gedi (David's hide out from Saul). Qumran. Ascend to Jerusalem. On our way to Jerusalem. Then onto the city of gold - Jerusalem - where we will view the old city from Mnt. Scopus. Spending the remaining nights in Jerusalem.

DAY 7 - APRIL 27

Tour Old City of Jerusalem

Visit Israel Museum, Yad Vashem, 2nd Temple Period Model. Then the Valley of Elah (where David slew Goliath).

DAY 8 - APRIL 28

New City of Jerusalem

Mnt. of Olives, Palm Sunday Path to Garden of Gethsemane, Upper room, Caiaphas' House, Jewish Quarter.

DAY 9 - APRIL 29

Final day in Jerusalem

Southern Steps of the Temple, Rabbis' Tunnel, Western Wall, Jewish Quarter. The Garden Tomb.

DAY 10 - APRIL 30

A day in Jerusalem (still being planned)

DAY 11 - MAY 1

Fly home early early morning.

Return Flight to LAX with many great memories and a lot of pictures!

Arrive home May 1.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Passport: A passport is required. If you do not have a current passport, please make an appointment with the postal service and allow 12 weeks after your appointment to complete the renewal process in the US. Passports must be valid until November 1, 2026 for this tour.

Travel Insurance is HIGHLY recommended for international travel. For best coverage, purchase your travel insurance within 2 weeks of booking your tour. Compare travel insurance options at this.

Deposits and Payments: A non-refundable deposit of \$250 is required from each traveler, along with your reservation form, to guarantee your space on the tour.

Final Payment is due 2/20/26.

(The supplement for "single occupancy" must be paid in full with the final payment).

Health and Mobility Challenges: Tours in Israel include areas that have uneven footing, few handrails, rocky pathways, and some steep climbs. The streets and sites we visit are not wheelchair and walker friendly. Most of our tours include 3-5 miles of walking per day. Guests with mobility challenges or other health issues should make private arrangements to travel with a caregiver who can stay with them if they need to opt out of a tour stop. Bus drivers are allowed breaks, and guests cannot be left alone on the bus if the bus is locked and unattended. If you have health challenges, please consult an Aliyah Tours representative before you put down a deposit on a tour.
