GETTING STARTED:

DIGGING IN:

What does this passage teach us about God?

What does this passage teach us about people?

What does this passage teach us about God's mission to reconcile the world?

DIGGING DEEPER:

How is Paul's personal comparison to the Corinthians useful? Is it sarcastic? Is it snide? When would there be a place for rebuke, if any?

If you could pick out the most important or the climactic verse in this chapter, (the line Paul wants to say) which line would you say it was?

C.S. Lewis said, "Humility is not thinking less of yourself, its thinking of yourself less." What is Paul doing in 1 Corinthians 4:13?

When does discipleship start? When did it start for you and how have you grown as a disciple? What have been the hardest challenges in being a disciple of Jesus?
