 - o Why is it significant that Jesus quotes from Genesis 2?
 - o How does knowing that the Pharisees considered themselves righteous as long as they were filling out the divorce certificate paperwork help us to understand Jesus' response?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 1. How has divorce impacted your life? Is there a place where you are still in the process of healing?
- 2. What are some ways that can help us to discern if a divorce is motivated by protecting people from the pain of broken pillars of unity and commitment OR if a divorce is motivated by looking for loopholes to do what I want?
- 3. Who can you think of that is a good example of God's power to heal and restore after a divorce? What is it in their life that makes them a good example?

- Pray for children you know who are growing up without a whole family. Look for ways to be an encouragement to them.
- · Pray for marriages in your group to be healthy.
- Pray for guidance & support for divorced people in your group or in your life to find healing and to draw close to Jesus in this season.
