

# Why It **Matters**

Acts 2:38-39 promises: Repent and be baptized... and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy. Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off. This hasn't passed away-it's for you! Jesus said in Luke 24:49 and Acts 1:8: Receive power (ability, efficiency, might) to be witnesses, live victoriously, and navigate daily life (even Walmart trips!).
