

WHY BELIEVERS TITHE!

Honoring GOD with the first-fruits of your income

Throughout Scripture, we are encouraged to give the first part of our resources to GOD as an expression of honor and gratitude. "Honor the Lord with thy substance, and with the first-fruits of all thine increase: So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine" (Proverbs 3:9-10, emphasis added). The first way to give of our "first-fruits" is to give a tithe, or the first ten percent of our income.



Understand the Biblical Basis for Tithing

Tithing is mentioned throughout the Old Testament, particularly when GOD commissioned the Israeli tribe of Levi to serve by caring for the tabernacle and providing spiritual leadership for the nation of Israel. Since the tribe of Levi was given these two unique responsibilities, GOD did not assign to them a portion of land as HE did to the other tribes of Israel, but HE instructed the rest of the Israelites to bring tithes of their increase to provide for the priests and Levites. (Numbers Chapter 18)

In the New Testament, Jesus affirmed the practice of tithing (see Matthew 23:23), and the Apostle Paul encouraged Christians to give to those in need and to those who were ministering in the Gospel (see 2 Corinthians 9:6–15). When you tithe today, you enable those whom GOD has called to serve as pastors, missionaries, and ministry personnel to faithfully build up the Church. You also enable the business of the church to flow effectively and efficiently and expand the Kingdom of GOD.

Biblical Obedience



- □ The Bible teaches tithing (giving 10% of income) as an act of obedience to GOD (Malachi 3:10, Leviticus 27:30).
- Offerings, beyond the tithe, are a way to show generosity and gratitude (2 Corinthians 9:7).
- Tithing reminds
 believers that everything
 belongs to GOD and that
 we are simply stewards

Support the Church's Mission



- □ Tithes and offerings support pastors, leaders, and staff so they can focus on spiritual care (1 Timothy 5:17–18).
- They provide resources for the church to carry out ministry—worship services, discipleship, evangelism, community outreach, and missions.
- Offerings often go to benevolence funds, helping those in need inside and outside the church.

Spiritual Growth & Trust

- Tithing helps believers put GOD first in their finances, building trust in His provision (Proverbs 3:9–10).
- It breaks the hold of greed and materialism, fostering contentment and faith.
- Giving develops a generous heart and aligns believers with GOD's nature and Word since HE is the ultimate giver.

Blessings & Kingdom Impact



- Scripture teaches that generosity leads to blessings, both spiritual and practical (Luke 6:38, 2 Corinthians 9:6).
- Tithing fuels Kingdom work—planting churches, feeding the hungry, caring for the poor, and spreading the Gospel globally.
- Giving leaves a legacy of faith and impacts lives for generations.

Tithing Honors GOD, Sustains the Church, Grows our Faith Blesses Others, and Multiplies Kingdom Impact.


