Study Questions

Before answering these questions, take some time to read the passage from the sermon together or on your own.

What did this sermon tell us about God?

What did this sermon tell us about us as people?

What did you hear in this sermon that applied the most to your own life?

Where do you primarily turn for wisdom? Would you categorize that as a godly or earthly source of wisdom? Which of the three primary sources of godly wisdom (scripture, prayer, fellow believers) could you use more in your relationship with Jesus?

Do you find yourself living life looking in a mirror or through a window? How can you shift to looking through the window more than looking in the mirror?

What is one area of your life where you particularly need wisdom right now? Once you identify it, pray for each other as a group or find someone to pray with you. Consider what each of the things listed in v. 17 look like in the area you identified.
