What are some ways that you are currently helping care for others by contributing to the life of our church? What are some ways that you could grow that contribution?

Are you discipling and being discipled? Who are some of your spiritual mentors (mothers/fathers) and how have they poured into/discipled you? Who are some of the people you have discipled (spiritual kids) and how did you help them grow in their faith?
