What did this sermon tell us about God?
What did this sermon tell us about us as people?
What did you hear in this sermon that applied the most to your own life?
Have you experienced what it is like to love someone else or be loved by someone because of what can be gotten out of you or them? What was that like? How did it make you feel? Did you notice any change in how you loved the or they loved you as the motivator for your love changed? What are some reasons for why loving Jesus this way is so dangerous?
How does Jesus' character and work help you trust him even if it seems there is no "payoff"? Are there areas in your life where you are expecting Jesus to give you something? If so, what are they? If not, what are some potential areas like that? How does knowing Jesus help you trust him when his plans and ways do not line up with your own?
What are some times of trouble or struggle in your life where you have gone to Jesus? How did you see him come through for you or help you? What are some things that left you disappointed? How

can those experiences bring you closer to Jesus in light of all we talked about in the message?
