## To Eat or Not To Eat

Leviticus 11

Two categories = Holy and Common

## Two categories:

## Holy

"And one called to another: Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of Armies; his glory fills the whole earth."

Isaiah 6:3 CSB

## Two categories:

Holy = God, the holy one

## Two categories:

Holy = God, the most holy one

Common = Everything else

## Holy

a person, place, or thing that has been brought into close proximity with or dedicated to the service of the God of Israel If something is common, it can exist in one of two states of being:

Clean

Unclean

# If something is common, it can exist in one of two states of being:

Clean = Default state unless stated otherwise

Unclean

"This is what you may eat from all that is in the water: You may eat everything in the water that has fins and scales, whether in the seas or streams. But these are to be abhorrent to you: everything in the seas or streams that does not have fins and scales among all the swarming things and other living creatures in the water."

Leviticus II:9-10 CSB

"All winged insects that walk on all fours are to be abhorrent to you. But you may eat these kinds of all the winged insects that walk on all fours: those that have jointed legs above their feet for hopping on the ground."

Leviticus II:20-21 CSB

#### Clean:

Sea animals: fish that have scales and fins

Sky animals: birds that have wings and two legs

Land animals: four legs that either hop, jump, or walk with hooves and chew the cud, insects that hop

#### Unclean:

Sea animals:

aquatic species that do not have fins and scales

Sky animals:

birds that dive and swim or eat other animals

Land animals: not four-legged and do not jump, hop,

or walk, or have hooves and do not chew the cud, insects that don't hop

#### Israelites could not eat:

Bacon Ham Pork

Scallops Shrimp Lobster

Crab Muscles Clams

"These will make you unclean. Whoever touches their carcasses will be unclean until evening, and whoever carries any of their carcasses is to wash his clothes and will be unclean until evening. All animals that have hooves but do not have a divided hoof and do not chew the cud are unclean for you. Whoever touches them becomes unclean."
