Psalm 110: A Royal Psalm aka King Jesus Has You Covered

<u>Big Idea:</u> Psalms 110 assures us we can rest *confidently* in and therefore offer ourselves *freely* to God, because of:

- The Person of Jesus Christ—He IS fully God as the Son of God
- The *Priestly Work of Christ*—His Sufficient Sacrifice Secures Our Salvation
- The Kingly Work of Christ—The Resurrected Christ Will Reign With His Resurrected Saints in the Millennial Kingdom
- I. We can rest confidently in and therefore offer ourselves freely to God, because of: The Person of Jesus Christ—He IS fully God (vv.1-3)
 - **A. 110:1** Who is "my Lord" (Adonai)?
 - 1. David? 2 Sam 5:10,12; 7:8-17. Saul? 1 Sam 24:6; 13:13-14. Solomon? Or someone greater? Zech 6:13
 - 2. According to Jesus: Matt 22:41-46/Mark 12:35-37/Luke 20:42-43
 - 3. According to Peter: Acts 2:32-38
 - 4. According to the author of Hebrews 1:3,13
 - 5. According to Jesus on trial for blasphemy: Matthew 26:62-66
 - B. What is the proper response? (Christ's deity isn't just a doctrine to check off!)
 - 1. Repent, be baptized, seek forgiveness, walk in Spirit: Acts 2:38
 - 2. Pay attn to Scripture, don't drift & don't neglect salvation: Heb 2:1-3
 - 3. Lay aside sin, run with endurance & fix eyes on Jesus: Heb 12:1-2
 - C. Who IS this God of Abraham (the God of the living Matt 22:32)?
 - 1. God Most High, Possessor of Heaven and Earth (Gen 14:22) God Almighty (17:1) Everlasting God (21:33)
 - 2. His ways are righteousness, justice, and lovingkindness (Gen 18:19,19:19)
 - 3. A Shield to you (Gen 15:1) God Who Sees (16:13) Who opens and closes wombs (16:2;17:16); God who provides (22:8)

- II. We can rest confidently in and therefore offer ourselves freely to God, because of: The Priestly Work of Christ—His Sufficient Sacrifice Secures Our Salvation (v4)
 - A. Who is Melchizedek?!
 - 1. Gen 14 Priest King of Salem who blesses Abram & Abram tithes to.
 - 2. Heb 7 "Made like the Son of God, he remains a priest perpetually."
 - B. Heb 7:22&25 "Jesus also has become the **guarantee** of a better covenant... therefore He is able also to save **forever** those who draw near to God through Him, since He **always lives** to make intercession for them."
 - C. What is the proper response?
 - 1. "Understanding what is required to come into God's presence helps us to appreciate the enormity of what Christ has done [for us]."

 - 2. Enter God's rest by **drawing near to Him** with full assurance to receive mercy & grace to help in time of need: Heb 10:21-22; 4:16
- III. We can rest confidently in and therefore offer ourselves freely to God, because of: The Kingly Work of Christ—The Resurrected Christ Will Reign with His Resurrected Saints in the Millennial Kingdom (vv. 2, 5-7)
 - A. Who are the enemies crushed under Christ's feet? (Ps 110:5-6; 1 Cor 15:20-26)
 - B. What will Christ's rule, dominion, and execution of judgment look like? (Psalm 110:2,6; 72:8-14; Isa 2:4/Micah 4:3)
 - C. What is the proper response?
 - 1. Offer yourselves freely to worship God's holy splendor: Ps 110:3
 - 2. Take shelter in His promises to lift OUR heads: Ps 3:3; 27:5-6; 110:7
 - 3. "Lift up YOUR heads, because your redemption is drawing near": Luke 21:28
 - 4. Act like citizens of His kingdom NOW-Do justice, love lovingkindness, walk humbly with your God: Micah 6:8
