- 3. **Confidentiality**: In order to maintain an atmosphere of intimacy and authenticity, I will hold what is shared in strict confidence. What is shared in the group stays in the group. With the exception being self-harm or the physical harm of someone else.
- 4. **Accountability**: I give permission to the group members to hold me accountable in my walk with Jesus and the goals I've set for myself.
- 5. **Assimilation**: I will strive to practice openness and hospitality within the group to keep the door open to others in our church and community who need what our group has to offer.
- 6. **The Bible**: While everyone's thoughts and opinions are valuable and encouraged, I will ultimately rely on the truth of Scripture as my final authority.
- 7. **Growth and Multiplication**: Healthy communities grow as they extend invitations to their friends. At a designated date, and working with FBC leadership, I will seek to multiply the group's influence by releasing new leaders and starting new groups.
