Christian Beliefs

Christian Beliefs are vital to Christian living. They are foundational to your relationship with God, as well as with others. What do Christians believe, and what difference do those beliefs make with God and others? This four-week study examines eight aspects of the Christian faith: The Revelation of God, God the Creator, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit, Humanity, Our Identity and Depravity, Church, and Community.

Christian Character

We should long for the beauty of Christ to be reflected in our lives, but how do we do that? Only as the Spirit of God transforms us through the Word of God. This 4 week study will cover eight aspects of Christian Character: The Lordship of Jesus, The Cost of Commitment, Freed to Serve God, Living Holy Lives, Showing Compassion, Serving Others, Using Your Spiritual Gifts, and Called to Persevere.

Christian Disciplines

Depth. Strength. Wisdom. Maturity. We should long to be people who exhibit such qualities. We want to strengthen our character and deepen our relationship with Christ. But spiritual depth requires spiritual discipline. This 4 week study will cover three aspects of Christian Discipline that can help us achieve these qualities: Connecting with God, Reaching out to Others, and Staying on Track.

Attributes of God

We are made and called to be in relationship with God. He makes that possible through Jesus' birth, life, death, resurrection, and ascension. While God transcends our comprehension, we should strive to know as much about Him as possible. This study challenges us to learn more about the God we strive to serve. We will look at the characteristics of God, and how these descriptions of His nature should influence our understanding of Him.

Christian Worldview

A worldview is the way we think the world works, and how we fit in it. Everyone has a worldview whether they are conscious of it or not. Understanding worldview is important because it shapes our thoughts, attitudes, and actions. A worldview answers four big questions: 1) Where do we come from; 2) Why is the world such a mess; 3) What can we do about it; and 4) What is my purpose in the world.
