### 2 - 3 Years

#### TOPIC

Mary, Joseph & The Angel (Luke 1:26-38)

#### QUESTIONS

- What was the Angel's name?
- What did the Angel tell Mary and Joseph?

#### BIG IDEA

God sends the Angel Gabriel to Mary and a dream to Joseph, each with an incredible message... The King, the Son of God is coming and His name is JESUS!

# 4 - 5 Years

## TOPIC

Waiting in Bethlehem (Luke 2:1-5)

## MEMORY VERSE

“Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord”

**Luke 2:11**

## QUESTION

- I wonder how Mary felt when they couldn't find somewhere to stay?
- I wonder what it was like waiting in the stable?
- I wonder if God was excited for His Son Jesus to be born?

## BIG IDEA

Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem and wait for God's Son to be born.

# K - 2nd Grade

## TOPIC

Zechariah (Advent Week 2)

## MEMORY VERSE

"For to us a child is born, for to us a son is given; the government shall be upon his shoulder, and he shall be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."

**Isaiah 9:6**

## QUESTIONS

- I wonder why God waited so long to give Zechariah and Elizabeth a baby?
- I wonder why the angel made Zechariah unable to talk?

## BIG IDEA

God shows his unwavering love for his people in his plan to rescue them - despite Elizabeth's barren womb and Zechariah's doubt. Their baby will get the people ready for the King.

## **ADVENT**

## **VERSE**

Neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Absence of conflict or fracturing AND presence of wholeness or completeness
