2 - 3 Years

TOPIC

Angels & Shepherds (Luke 2:25-38)

QUESTIONS

- What appeared to the shepherds?
- What was the good news?

BIG IDEA

God announces the good news of the birth of His Son first to the shepherds.

4 - 5 Years

TOPIC

Good News for the Shepherds (Luke 2:8-15)

MEMORY VERSE

"Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he Is the Messiah, the Lord"

Luke 2:11

QUESTION

- I wonder how the shepherds felt as the sky filled with bright lights and the angel appeared in the sky?
- I wonder if they understood what the Angels were saying?

BIG IDEA

God announces the good news of the birth of His Son first to the shepherds.

K - 2nd Grade

TOPIC

Mary & Joseph (Luke 1:26–38, Matthew 1:18–25)

MEMORY VERSE

"For to us a child is born, for to us a son is given; the government shall be upon his shoulder, and he shall be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."

Isaiah 9:6

QUESTIONS

- I wonder how Mary felt when she saw the angel?
- Did Mary believe that what the angel said was true?

BIG IDEA

God sends the Angel Gabriel to Mary and a dream to Joseph, each with an incredible message... The King, the Son of God is coming and His name is JESUS!

3rd - 5th Grade

ADVENT

Joy is the satisfaction of living your life filled with the hope, peace, and love of God.

VERSE

Though you have not seen him, you love him... and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your souls.
