Children's Ministry

Grace Kids is an opportunity for any child visiting or attending GCC to be discipled through studying scripture and worshiping in age-appropriate ways. On Sundays we offer nursery and classes for children, birth through 6th grade during our first hour. During our worship hour birth through kindergarten may remain downstairs, but all other children join our corporate worship until the 1st through 4th graders only transition to classes for the remainder of our gathering. When a month includes a 5th Sunday, we have our Grace Kids, ages 1st-4th grade, remain to participate in the full worship gathering upstairs with their families.

After being at GCC for 6 months you are welcome to serve in Grace Kids. We take our children's safety very seriously here and every adult serving in Grace Kids has a current background check. We take June and July off in Grace Kids for summer travel and a time of rest for our teachers. However, nursery/preschool run year round.

Worship Ministry

Music & Singing

We believe corporate worship of music and singing is important to and expected by Lord as He gathers and assembles His church each week. God gives us clear instruction (Col. 3:16; Eph. 5:19) on how and why we come together to lift our voices together in song. We want to be obedient to the Lord by singing together each week. In these scriptures, and others, we see that singing songs of worship help the Word of God take deep root in our lives. Whether it's singing the truths of who God is and who we are in Him, or using melodies put to scripture, we are memorizing and hiding His word in our hearts. Additionally, we build each other up when we worship through singing. We "address one another" in song for the purpose of encouraging, serving, and challenging each other. The Lord is glorified when His people gather to worship Him. Many voices, all raised in unity, are powerful to all who hear and the Lord works through his people when they do this.

*Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples!

At GCC, there are many opportunities to serve and lead in our worship gatherings and ministry events. Our musical worship is led by teams of singers and musicians, but is also supported by other roles in audio, video, and production.

Audio/Visual

The A/V Ministry Team at GCC serves the body of Christ by helping to create an environment that is conducive to worshipping our Lord and Savior. We are responsible for all of the audio and visual presentations that occur during gatherings at Grace Community Church, including those that happen on the grounds, as well as through our livestream. While we welcome creative expertise, having a servant's heart is even more important.

The ministry is currently organized into three focus areas, which include presentation (the graphics that are displayed during the service), video production (video switching and the livestream production), and sound. Team members are welcome to focus on a single area or cross train in multiple areas. We ask team members to volunteer at least one Sunday per month, and commitments can range from 15 minutes to several hours depending upon your availability.

Global Missions

God makes it clear in His Word that He has called the church to reach the nations with the good news of his Son, Jesus. GCC takes this seriously and currently partners with over 15 missionaries and mission organizations around the world. We define missions as gospel-centered ministry that crosses barriers of distance, culture, and language in order to establish and strengthen the church outside the USA. We see ourselves as a Sending Church, and are focused on strengthening discipleship as preparation to go to the nations. We also offer opportunities to participate in missions from home through Advocacy Care Teams (ACTs) for each of our missionaries, adult Sunday school classes, short-term trips, and by providing hospitality for visiting missionaries.



The goal of missions at GCC is to see every people group on earth have access to:

- 1) Gospel proclamation, including the Bible in their own language
- 2) Discipleship
- 3) A church that adheres to scripture and is self-sustaining and self-replicating

ACT - Advocacy Care Teams

Small groups of church members who commit to encourage, pray, and deepen relationship with a particular missionary through regular communication and prayer.

"Pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should." Colossians 4:3-4

Missions Committee

Members serve in one or more areas of Administration (budget, policy), Education (classes, newsletter), Missionary Care (hospitality, ACTs, agency relationships), and Short-term Trips (planning, training). Meetings are held monthly.

Events and Hospitality

Prayer

The intention of the Ministry of Prayer GCC is to do nothing more than to place all of our focused attention upon our Heavenly Father as is rightly due Him. We have the privilege of addressing Him, by prayer, in and through His Son Jesus. It is only through Him and by His name, that we can gain access to the Father, as He is our direct mediator.

For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time.

1 Timothy 2:5-6

Scripture gives us many glimpses of prayer and the way that we are to approach Him, a Holy God. Whether it be in the Old Testament or the New Testament, God is most interested at the condition of our heart and that we revere Him above all others. Humility and the recognition of who He is, are a big part of prayer, as we come to the understanding what He has done on our behalf. His desire is to restore a relationship between Himself and man that originally was perfect, but then was broken by man's sin. He desires close fellowship with us, which is accomplished through prayer and the reading of His word.



Mathew 6:5-15 and Luke 11:1-13 are two locations in scripture, where Jesus teaches His followers the manner in which they were to pray. Both of these references direct His followers to the recognition of God as the One who is to be most revered. He then directs us to be looking and longing for His perfect kingdom that He has established. Jesus then goes on to help us understand that when in right relationship with God, we understand and affirm that He is the provider of all our needs, which should produce a thankful heart within us. Jesus teaches us in this example of prayer, that when we sin, we can reach out our loving Heavenly Father for restoration through His forgiveness and that this forgiveness is to be modeled by us, as we forgive others who've sinned against us.

Jesus continues to teach us further in Mathew 6:25-34 that we are not to be anxious about anything, that He knows our need, and that our main focus should be to pursue His will.

It is the desire of the elders that we be known as a house of prayer. May our love for the Lord be evident in the way we pray for others. It is our desire that our children, grandchildren, and others, see a community of believers, dependent upon our Lord for everything. May we model this by the way they see us pray, as we expectantly wait for God to do His work among us, all for His Honor and Glory.

Finance Committee

The finance committee at GCC consists of a guiding elder oversight, financial secretary, and volunteer church members. Each member serves a strategic role in managing a safe and secure financial environment. GCC's philosophy regarding confidentiality of donor information is that it is restricted to very specific individuals on the committee. The Elders do not see detailed donor information which allows them to make healthy decisions for the church that are not influenced by the donor.

Regarding debt, GCC strives to operate the church without borrowed funds. This does not preclude taking on debt, but debt financing of a project would be the last option taken.

The committee is always open to members providing assistance and guidance to the Financial Secretary and Elder Board either on an ongoing basis or as a temporary task. Some of the opportunities could include assisting in monthly financial statements or journal entries, annual budget process, providing regular updates to elders, or advising on financial and insurance needs.
