Overview: The mission pastor's main and ongoing duty will be to help the church carry out its mission to make disciples of Jesus Christ. Performing this task will involve the missions pastor in various areas of church life. The missions pastor will work closely and collaboratively with the church staff, helping to plan and perform church events, programs, and services. Depending on the church's needs, the worship pastor might take on specific ministry responsibilities.

The Mission's Pastor will work under the leadership and guidance of the pastor. He will assist the pastor in all facets of the ministry. He shall be available to the pastor, staff, deacon body, leaders, teachers, and congregation to further the Kingdom of God. The Mission Pastor at College Heights will have the unique opportunity to shape his role in accordance with his spiritual gifts and areas of passion, in alignment with the church's mission and needs. While certain core responsibilities are expected, we are committed to working with the Mission Pastor to tailor his duties to best suit his giftings. These responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Ability to make connections around the world.
- Ability to travel and to lead others in outreach ministries and mission trips locally, nationally, and internationally.
- The missions pastor may be a point of contact for any overseas missionaries the church supports. This may involve representing their interests to the church leaders, reporting to the congregation on the missionary's programs, needs and results.
- Share in the preaching and teaching responsibilities.
- Engage in pastoral care duties, including but not limited to, counseling, visiting the sick and homebound, and conducting weddings and funerals.
- Lead and develop others to lead, in discipleship, evangelism, biblical understanding, and loving and serving others.

- Recruit and equip volunteers in ministries.
- Lead Bible studies.
