## **Memorize Me:**

# **○ Need to Know:**

God's Word Is God's Story.

# Fantastic 5:

Here's a simple 5-point recap of this week's Bible story (Genesis 1–3):

- 1. In the beginning, God made everything—light, land, sea, animals, people—and He said it was all *very good*.
- 2. God made Adam and Eve in His image to be close to Him and take care of His creation.
- 3. God gave them a choice—to trust Him and obey His command not to eat from one specific tree.
- 4. But the serpent lied to Eve, and both Adam and Eve disobeyed God. This brought sin into the world.
- Even though they disobeyed, God still loved them. He gave them a promise of hope and made a way for us to be close to Him again through Jesus.

# Ask Me This!

(Perfect for the ride home, bedtime, or the dinner table Sunday)

- 1. What are some of the things God created?
- 2. What did God ask Adam and Eve not to do?
- 3. What happened when they disobeyed God?
- 4. How do we know God still loved them even after they made a mistake?

# Take Off! (Try this at home throughout the week!)

- Go on a nature walk and let your child point out things God created. Talk about how amazing and creative God is. (Tuesday)
- Read Genesis 1:1–2:3 together and have your child draw their favorite part of creation. (Thursday)
- Talk about what it means to believe God's Word—even when others try to tell us something different. (Friday)
- Help your child memorize Genesis 1:1 and talk about how God made everything with a purpose—including them! (Saturday)



## 🙏 Prayer Guide: A Heart After God

## Opening:

"Dear God, thank You for creating this beautiful world and making us to know You."

### Thanksgiving:

"Thank You for the story of creation and for loving us, even when we mess up."

#### Confession:

"Forgive us for the times we don't listen to You or trust what You say. Help us to believe Your Word is true."

### **Prayer for the Child:**

"God, help [child's name] believe Your Word, trust Your voice, and follow You. Give them a heart like Yours."

### **Prayer for Strength & Guidance:**

"Give [child's name] the strength to say no to temptation and to remember Your promises every day."

#### Closing:

"Thank You, God, for always wanting to walk with us and help us grow closer to You. In Jesus' name, Amen."

# **▼** Parent Challenge:

This week, take a moment with your child to step outside and enjoy God's beautiful creation—watch the clouds, listen to the birds, or go for a walk. Talk about how God made the whole world and called it *good*, and how He made people to be in close relationship with Him.

Then, gently talk about how Adam and Eve made a wrong choice in the garden, and how we all sometimes choose our own way instead of God's. Share a story from your own life when you made a mistake and needed God's forgiveness. Ask your child if there's anything they'd like to talk to God about too.

End your time by thanking God together for His love, forgiveness, and His desire to be close to us again—just like He walked with Adam and Eve in the garden.
