Memorize Me:

"I will make them want to know Me. They will know that I am the Lord. They will be My people, and I will be their God." - Jeremiah 24:7

• Need to Know:

God Is Love.

Fantastic 5 (1 John 4:7–21)

- 1. The Bible teaches us that real love comes from God, because God Himself is love.
- 2. We can know what love looks like because God showed it by sending His Son, Jesus, to save us.
- 3. When we believe in Jesus, God's love lives in us and changes the way we treat others.
- 4. God calls us to love one another—if we truly love, it shows that we belong to Him.
- 5. Perfect love drives out fear, and because of God's love, we can love Him and love others with confidence.

? Ask Me This!

(Perfect for the ride home, bedtime, or the dinner table Sunday)

- 1. Where does real love come from?
 - a. 1 John 4:7-8
- 2. How did God show His love for us?
 - a. 1 John 4:9-10
- 3. What happens when we believe in Jesus and accept His love?
 - a. 1 John 4-15-16
- 4. Why does God want us to love other people?
 - a. 1 John 4:11-12
- 5. How does God's perfect love take away our fear?
 - a. 1 John 4:18

Take Off! (Try this at home throughout the week!)

- **Tuesday:** Read 1 John 4:7–12 together and talk about how God showed His love by sending Jesus.
- **Thursday:** Share ways your family can show love to others—like helping a neighbor, writing a kind note, or praying for someone in need.
- **Saturday:** Make a "Love Poster." Write "God is Love" in big letters and decorate it with hearts and pictures of people you love. Hang it where everyone can see it.
- All Week: Pray together, asking God to fill your family with His love so you can share it with others.



Prayer Guide: God's Love Lives in Us

Opening:

"Dear God, thank You for showing us what real love looks like."

Thanksgiving:

"Thank You for sending Jesus to die for us so we can know Your love and share it with others."

Confession:

"Forgive us when we don't show love or when we put ourselves first. Help us to choose love instead."

Prayer for the Child:

"God, help [child's name] to know how much You love them and to share that love with others every day."

Prayer for Strength & Guidance:

"Holy Spirit, fill [child's name] with Your love and teach them how to love others with kindness, patience, and joy."

Closing:

"Thank You, Lord, that Your perfect love drives away fear. Help our family to stay close to You and live in Your love. In Jesus' name, Amen."

▼ Parent Challenge

This week, share with your child a story about a time when you experienced God's love through someone else's kindness or forgiveness. Talk about how that moment helped you understand God's love more deeply.

Read 1 John 4:7–21 together and remind your child that we can love others because God first loved us. Encourage your child to think of one person they can show love to this week in a practical way—through words, actions, or prayer.

Pray together as a family, asking God to fill your hearts with His love and to help you share it with everyone around you.
