Here's a peek at what your amazing kid learned this Sunday in KidZone. Use this guide to talk about it at home this week and grow in faith together!

🧠 **Memorize Me:**

"Your Word to me, Your servant, is like pure gold; I treasure what You say." — Psalm 119:140

💬 **Need to Know:**

God's Word is true.

🙌 **Fantastic 5:**

Here's a simple 5-point recap of this week's Bible story (1 Kings 17):

1. God told the prophet Elijah there would be no rain for a long time, and He sent Elijah to a stream where God provided food through ravens!
 2. When the stream dried up, God told Elijah to go to a widow who would take care of him.
 3. Even though the widow only had a little flour and oil left, she trusted God's word and made food for Elijah first—and God made her food last until the drought was over!
 4. Later, the widow's son became very sick and died. Elijah cried out to God, and God brought the boy back to life!
 5. The widow saw God's power and said, "Now I know that the word of the Lord from your mouth is the truth."
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? Ask Me This!

(Perfect for the ride home, bedtime, or the dinner table Sunday)

1. How did God take care of Elijah during the drought?
 2. What did the widow do with the last of her food?
 3. What happened to the widow's son, and how did God answer Elijah's prayer?
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Take Off! (Try this at home throughout the week!)

- **Monday** – Talk with your child about ways your family has seen God provide (money, food, friends, help, peace, etc.)
 - **Wednesday** – Read 1 Kings 17:8–16 together and talk about how the widow trusted what God said.
 - **Friday** – Write or draw a list of things your family needs right now. Pray together and believe that God hears you like He heard Elijah.
 - **Weekend** – Take turns sharing a moment when God helped you even when things were hard. Celebrate His faithfulness with worship music or a thankful walk outside.
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Prayer Guide: A Heart That Trusts God's Word

Opening:

“Dear God, thank You for always speaking truth through Your Word.”

Thanksgiving:

“Thank You for the story of Elijah and how You provided food, hope, and even brought the widow's son back to life.”

Confession:

“Sometimes we forget how powerful You are. Forgive us for the times we doubt You or don't pray like we should.”

Prayer for the Child:

“God, please help [child's name] to believe in Your Word and trust that You are always near, listening, and working.”

Prayer for Strength & Guidance:

“Give [child's name] courage to pray bold prayers and remind them that You hear them, just like You heard Elijah.”

Closing:

“Thank You, God, for being our provider, our listener, and our source of truth. We love You. In Jesus' name, Amen.”

Parent Challenge:

This week, take a moment to talk with your child about a time when your family needed something—whether it was help, peace, provision, or direction—and how God showed up. If you're still waiting on something now, invite your child to pray with you and trust that God hears.

Read 1 Kings 17:17–24 together and talk about how Elijah cried out to God—and God listened. Remind your child that no prayer is too big or too small for God to hear. Encourage them to bring their worries and needs to God, trusting that He cares and responds with love and power.
