God Loves the Israelites





(Exodus 32:1–19; Exodus 34:1–11)

1. While Moses was on the mountain with God, the Israelites became impatient and forgot to trust God.
 2. They made a golden calf and worshiped it instead of the one true God.
 3. God was disappointed, but Moses prayed for the people and asked God to forgive them.
 4. God listened to Moses and showed mercy, reminding His people of His great love.
 5. God renewed His promise to the Israelites, showing that even when people mess up, **God's love never stops.**
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? Ask Me This!

(Perfect for the ride home, bedtime, or around the dinner table)

1. **What did the Israelites do while Moses was on the mountain?**
📖 Exodus 32:1–4 — They made a golden calf and worshiped it.

2. **How did God feel about what the Israelites did?**
 *Exodus 32:9–10* — God was disappointed because they turned away from Him.
 3. **Who prayed and asked God to forgive the people?**
 *Exodus 32:11–14* — Moses prayed for the Israelites.
 4. **What did God show Moses about who He is?**
 *Exodus 34:6–7* — God showed that He is loving, patient, and forgiving.
 5. **What does this story teach us about God's love?**
 *Exodus 34:10–11* — God keeps loving His people and keeps His promises, even when they make mistakes.
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Take Off!

(Try this together throughout the week!)

- **Tuesday:** Read *Exodus 32:1–7* and talk about why it's important to trust God while waiting.
 - **Thursday:** Read *Exodus 34:6–7* and describe God using the words from the verse (loving, patient, forgiving).
 - **Saturday:** Share a family story about a time someone made a mistake and still felt loved and forgiven.
 - **All Week:** Say together:
“God promises to love me—no matter what!”
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Prayer Guide

God Promises To Love Me

Opening:

“Dear God, thank You for loving us all the time.”

Thanksgiving:

“Thank You for loving the Israelites and for loving our family so much.”

Confession:

“Forgive us when we make wrong choices or forget to trust You.”

Prayer for the Child:

“God, help [child's name] always remember how deeply You love them.”

Prayer for Strength & Guidance:

“Holy Spirit, help [child's name] follow You and trust Your love every day.”

Closing:

“Thank You for never giving up on us. We love You, Lord. In Jesus' name, Amen.”

Parent Challenge

This week, talk with your child about **unconditional love**—loving even when someone messes up.

Read *Exodus 32–34* together and explain how God corrected His people but never stopped loving them.

Encourage your child to show love through kindness, forgiveness, and obedience this week.

End the week by thanking God together for His never-ending love in your family's life.
