STATEMENT OF BELIEFS Messiah's New Life Tabernacle

- 1. "All scripture is given by inspiration of Yahweh, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of Yahweh may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works." 2 Timothy 3:16,17.
- 2. According to the Holy Spirit Inspired Scriptures, YAHWEH is the Hebrew name of the Creator, and Yeshua (commonly called Jesus) is the English form for the Savior's Name as transliterated from the Hebrew language.
- 3. Yeshua is the Only Begotten Son of Yahweh, formed by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Miriam (Mary), and Yeshua is the ONLY MEDIATOR between Yahweh and men. I Timothy 2:5, John 3:16, Isaiah. 7:14, Matt. 1:20-23, Luke 1:30-35,
- 4. Salvation is a gift of Yahweh: "For by grace are you saved through faith: and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of Yahweh: not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Yeshua the Messiah unto good works, which Yahweh hath before ordained that we should walk in them." Ephesians 2:8-10; Romans 3:20-28, 4:13
- 5. Repentance, conversion, sanctification, and immersion (in water) must be preached. Luke 13:3, Luke 13:5; Acts 2:38-39; Acts 3:19; Exodus 31:13-17; Acts 8:36-39; Acts 16:13-15,
- "Sin is the transgression of the law," I John 3:4. "All His commandments., are sure. They stand fast forever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness." Psalms 111:7-8; 1 John 5:17; Psalms 119:172; James 4:17, Matt 19:16-49
- 7. The baptism of the Holy Spirit and the nine gifts of the Spirit are for the followers of Yeshua today, and each follower of Yeshua must live a clean, humble, Holy Spirit-filled life; manifestations of the Spirit regulated according to I Cor 12 and 14, Matt 3:11-12, Luke 3:16-17, Acts 11:15-16
- 8. Prayer and anointing will heal the sick James 3:14-15, Mark 6:12-13.
- 9. The paying of tithe should be practiced by Yahweh's children. Matt. 23:23; Proverbs 3:9-10; Malachi 3:8-10; 2 Cor. 9:1-13.
- 10. The law of clean and unclean is still to be observed and taught. Leviticus 11, Deut. 14, Isaiah 65:2-4, Isaiah 66:17, Acts 15:29, 2 Cor. 6:17.
- 11. Yahweh in six days made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day. Genesis 2:1-3; Exodus 20:11; Hebrews 4:4, 4:9, 4:10.
- 12. The seventh day of the week should be observed from evening to evening as Yahweh's Sabbath. Genesis 1:5, 1:8, 1:13, 1:19, 1:23, 1:31; Lev. 23:32.
- 13. Yeshua proved His Messiahship by remaining in the tomb exactly three days and three nights, rising in the end of or late on the Sabbath. Matt. 12:38-40.
- 14. The Feasts of Yahweh commanded in Leviticus 23 are still to be observed as a memorial by the Believers today. Exodus 23:14-17, Leviticus 23:1-44, Zechariah 14:16-19, John 7:8-10, Acts 18:21, 1 Corinthians 5:8
- 15. The Passover which consists of unleavened bread and the fruit of the vine is to be observed annually in honor of our Savior's death, in the beginning (dark part) of the 14th of Abib Matt... 26:26-29; Luke 22:7-20; 1 Cor 5:7, 8; 1 Cor. 11:23-34.
- 16. The return of Yahushua will be literal, perceivable to the eye, personal and is impending. I Thess. 4:13-18; Acts 1:11; Rev 1:7; Rev. 19:11-21.

- 17. The kingdom of Yahweh will be established under the leadership and in the person of Yeshua the Messiah on the throne of David at Jerusalem during the restitution of all things or during the one thousand-year reign of the Savior on earth beginning at the second coming of Yeshua Isaiah 9:6-7, Luke 13:1, 13:32; Rev 20:4-5.
- 18. The righteous are resurrected and rewarded at the second coming of Yeshua, Matt, 16:27; II Cor. 5:10; I Cor, 3:8; Rev-11:18; 1Thess. 4:13-18
- 19. The saints shall inherit the earth and will reign with the Savior on earth during the millennium and throughout eternity. Psalm 37:11; Matt. 5:5; Rev. 20:5-6; Proverbs 10:30.
- 20. The dead are unconscious Psalms 6:5, Ps 88:12, Ps 115:17, 146:4, Ecc. 3:19-21, Ecc 9:5, Ecc 9:10
- 21. The wicked dead are resurrected to final judgment, and not to a second trial or chance. Hebrews 9:27; 2 Peter 2:9; Rev. 20:12-15.
- 22. The wicked will be eternally destroyed. John 3:16, I John 5:12, Rev. 21:8. Malachi 4:1.
- 23. The Biblical teaching of holy marriage is only between one man and one woman that God hath joined together to become one flesh. Genesis 2:22-24; Matt. 19:5, 6.
- 24. Same sex marriages, unions (so-called) is an abomination and will be judged. Lev. 18:22; 20:13; Romans 1:24-27.
- 25. The governing body with the anointing of the Holy Spirit is the Assembly's sole interpreter of scripture. I John 2:27.
- 26. A bishop, elder and deacon must be the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behavior, given to hospitality; able to teach; not given to wine, no striker, not greedy, of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous, one that ruleth well his own house and not a novice. I Timothy 3:1-10, Titus 1:5-9.
